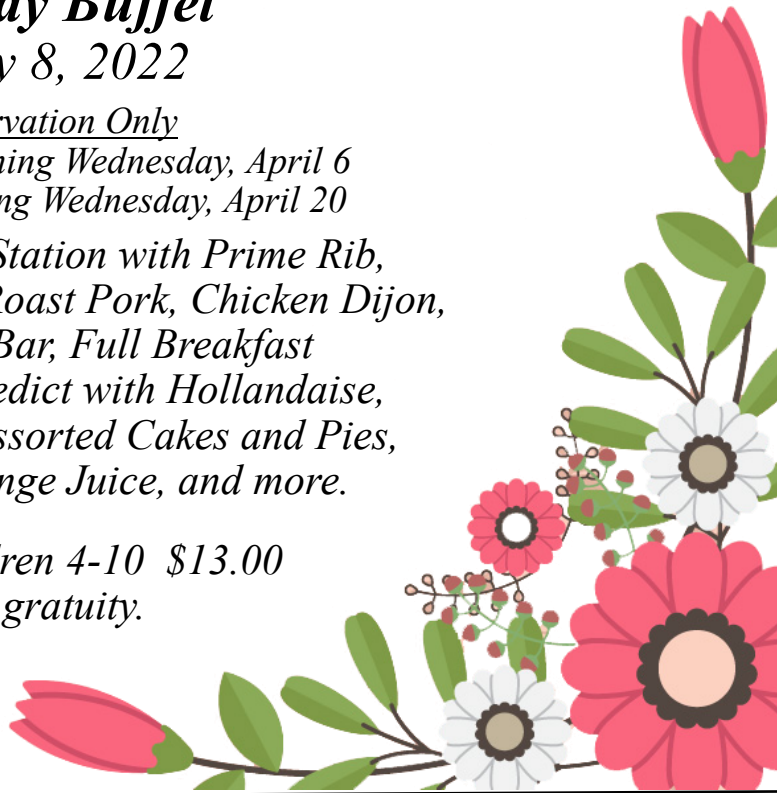

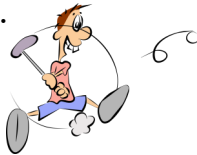

With a coming of summer and the heat it brings it will be a welcomed respite to take a short break until we get up and running again for our fall season. The social committee will break for the summer months, and look forward to seeing everyone again next fall.

## General Manager's Corner

Bloomings, our Landscape Contractor, has started to work on the area surrounding the parking lot. The following is a summary of what has been done and what will be completed by the middle of April:

1. The old hedge has been removed.
2. Due to the "Witches' Broom" disease the Bottle Brush trees were cut down and the roots removed with a stump grinder.
3. The irrigation system was repaired and all new heads were installed.
4. The new plantings being put in will mirror the plantings along Peridia Boulevard.
5. The area along the north side of the parking lot will be planted with grass.
6. The Mexican petunia will be removed and replaced with an assortment of plants that will eventually hide the electrical box at the north east corner of the parking lot.

This summer, our golf course will remain open on Thursdays for our golfers to enjoy their game of golf. We will be closing the course on Tuesday, May 10th through Sunday, May, 15<sup>th</sup> for major maintenance. Ray is planning to have an outside company come in and prune all of the roots that surround the trees on the golf course. This pruning will help grow grass in and around the tree areas. During the closing the greens, tees, fairways and some rough areas will be aerified. This work will cause the course to look like a bomb went off but after heeling the course will be in much better shape. During the summer months there will be an additional number of days that the course will be closed during the afternoon hours for work by outside contractors.

The rubber matting around the outside of the Pro Shop needs to be replaced. The plan is to replace the rubber square flooring with 4 x 6 sheets of 1/2 inch black rubber matting.

Our annual meeting is on Monday, April the 11th, at 6:00PM at the Braden River Presbyterian Church. The agenda has been posted on our bulletin board at the front entrance of the clubhouse and notification of the meeting appeared in our March Scorecard.

Activities at the clubhouse and the high number of rounds of golf have put a premium on the parking spaces in our lot. We see this as a result of successful growth. Peridia has become a destination for our neighbors outside of Peridia to come and join in on the fun. This problem will solve itself in the next couple of weeks with the snow birds heading back up north. I have asked our cart attendants to keep our golf carts in areas that are not taking up a parking spot as it is very important to have places for golfers to park.

Those members who have purchased a cart as their second vehicle and use it to come to the Club must follow the same rules as any automobile coming into our parking lot. Carts parked in a handicap space must display a handicap placard. Also, there is no parking on the sidewalks or in any of the grassy areas around the Pro Shop, the cart barn or the Tiki bar. All carts must park in one of the parking spots provided for automobile parking.

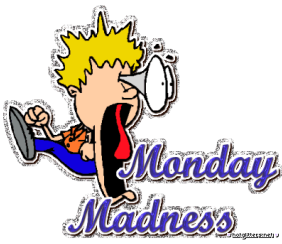

## **Speeding, untrustworthy contractors, Robo calls and more.....**

It's April already – it sure has been a busy season for everyone. Soon, many of our snowbird friends will return to their other homes and they are always missed so much. Fortunately, many of the neighbors that have moved to Peridia since 2021 are full time residents, so we have more neighbors here in the summer than in previous years. There continues to be heavy traffic in our area and a lot of speeding within Peridia. I have had conversations with Manatee County Sheriff's office regarding this, as have other residents, but unfortunately with the housing explosion in Manatee Co. they do not always have resources to set up signs/flashing lights, etc., to deter the speeders. If you would like to report speeding, please call the Traffic Hotline at 941 723-5197. It is helpful to get the license plate number or description of the car, but do not try and stop the driver or yell obscenities to them. They have however, been placing officers on 45<sup>th</sup> Street in the evenings and have given out quite a few speeding tickets. So please be careful when walking or even driving in the neighborhood.

We have had several members that have been taken advantage of by contractors that agree to remodel and require a large deposit up front and don't complete the work. Do not pay in advance for remodeling work. If you should decide to have work done by someone that you do not know, or has not been recommended by a friend or relative, please 'vet' this individual (s) and research complaints, lawsuits filed, etc. Also, if they provide a Florida Contractor's license, please check to see if it is a valid number and if it is current. If it is not, do not use them. Also, don't open the door to people soliciting for anything including windows, solar panels, etc. If they were legitimate, they would not be going door to door. The people are recruited by scammers who drive them into the neighborhood and park somewhere where you cannot see the car or license plate number. Recently a man posing as a landscaper using someone else's business cards, signed up customers, required them to pay in advance, and they were never seen or heard from again. While I think that most of the businesses that advertise in the Scorecard are legitimate, it is the homeowner's responsibility to check them out; do not assume that Peridia has done that. They sell advertising to off-set the cost of publishing 650 Scorecards a month but are not responsible for the business' work practices.

We all have received ROBO calls from "Police Support Group". These calls are pre-recorded and use language that suggests they are charities raising money directly for local police, when they are instead independent, expenditure-only political action groups. The PACS are not scrutinized like charities are and are not required to register with the IRS and the states they are operating in. One that is especially active is called Law Enforcement for a Safer America PAC. Research revealed that in 2021 they reported donations of over \$2M with the bulk going to 'overhead, fundraising, lawyers, etc., and none going to supporting police.

Crime wise, it has been very quiet, but please remember to lock your vehicles if left outside, keep your garage doors down and if you see something that looks unusual or suspicious, say something by calling 911. Peridia continues to be a wonderful place to live, work and play! Get out and enjoy the amenities and meet your neighbors. For those of you who are leaving soon, make sure that anything that is outside or on your lanai that can damage your property or your neighbor's house is brought inside and that your home is protected as much as possible in preparation for Hurricane Season. Make sure someone locally can enter your house in case of an emergency.
