Happy December everyone!! I hope all of you have had a great holiday season thus far with Christmas coming up quickly. Please have a safe and fun holiday season.


The PLGA have their Christmas Lunch and Scramble on December 15th. Make sure to sign up in the Pro Shop ASAP.

I met two new couples at the Welcome Back Party this past Friday, all were very excited about moving into Peridia. Both couples mirrored each other's conversation with me, saying that picking Peridia as their new home has been a perfect match. WOW! Both telling me how friendly everyone in Peridia have been during their first couple of months. How great the shape of the Golf Course is in, how much fun it is playing and how relaxed everyone seems to be. They have been coming to the Tiki Bar and spending their food minimum while meeting new friends. One couple complimented Chef Todd's Friday night's menu and Judy's selection of Bands. Comments like those tell us that we are on the right track in keeping the Club for our members as the number one destination for sports, food, drinks and friendship.

This year Chef Todd and Judy have been working very hard to provide our members with daily menus that provide a variety of selections to choose from which makes us different from your standard restaurant that has the same menu each day. Please continue using this service.

Judy has put together a busy seasonal program but at the same time provide a safe environment for our members to enjoy the seasonal programs. Instead of opening our functions to 130 members, we will only be allowing 80 to 90 members at each function this year. That means that you will need to make your reservations early.

Our Sunday Brunch has been one of our best attended functions but due to the Covid-19 restrictions we will **not** start our Brunch's until sometime in 2021. Our Friday Night bands will be cut back to every other Friday during the 2021 season. Bingo will be the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month. Our Pasta Nights, Birthday Buffet nights, Prime Nights and others will happen but won't be scheduled more than 30 days out, so watch for your favorite night advertised in the Scorecard and reserve your table ASAP. The bad news for this upcoming season is that Monday Night Madness will not be back until we feel that it is safe for that big of a gathering. Tiki Bar is the gathering place for drinking, eating and friendly conversations. Yes, the same menu items that you see on your daily e-mail blasts are offered at the tiki bar. Stop by after Golf, Pickleball, Tennis, Mah Jongg, Bridge, Fun Cards, Canasta, Committee meetings or after your HOA meeting, to relax and enjoy your favorite refreshment.

Mona has asked that I take the time today to remind all of you that the Holidays are just around the corner and your family and friends will be starting to come down to visit you soon. Please remind your family and friends that Peridia has a dress code while playing golf or visiting the Clubhouse (see Dress Code article in this Scorecard). I hope that you have already visited the Tiki Bar and observed all the changes. Work on the pool and bar area began on July 6. The start was somewhat slow because we had to repair a leak in the pool. And, of course, the leak was in the most difficult location.

But the work progressed steadily over the next three months. Landscaping was removed, and the concrete deck was greatly expanded. An existing walk and a 13 foot by 20 foot slab of concrete were removed and replaced. Wiring to the Tiki bar was improved.

A fence was placed around the perimeter and perimeter lighting was installed. The entire surface was texture coated with acrylic cement and color coating. The pool also was completely resurfaced.

The two biggest contractors were Lumsden Concrete and Galaxy Pools. The total cost for the project was \$96,205. An additional \$26,000 was allocated for new tables, chairs, awnings and fire pits. When everything has finally arrived and been set up, the GM tells us we will have seating for 100+ in the Tiki Bar area. The bar and pool re-opened on October 5.

After the contractors had finished, we had some local artisans do the decorative painting at the Tiki Bar. This group included Dixie Barnes, Joan Springer, Judy Hahn and Dana Gainey. A big thank you goes to these ladies for helping make the area even more attractive. I stated last month that the tennis/pickleball courts might be an attraction for new residents and should be a source of pride for all Peridians. The same holds true for the Tiki Bar and pool.

Here is a great way to USE THE CLUB - celebrate happy hour at the Tiki Bar.




