To All Peridia Residents,



Interview with Neal Dollar: Partnership Specialist with the Atlanta Regional Census Center

Q. We heard the Census is coming up soon.

Neal: Yes, the initial mailing of the census questionnaire will go out to all households on March 12th. This year, we are asking that you complete the Census online.

Q. Online??? What if I don't have a computer or can't find the link to the Census?

Neal: You can access the form on your smart phone, I Pad, etc. If you need help, it will be available at the library. We will also give you an 800 number to call for assistance.

Q. What if I don't respond?

Neal: You will receive a follow-up post card reminder around March 19th and again around March 26th. The Census questionnaire will be mailed to you around April 2nd if you haven't responded online before that. After that, if we still don't have a response from you, someone will come to your door.

Q. Why does it matter if I respond or not?

Neal: Well, for one thing, \$675 billion in federal dollars are distributed to communities based on the number of people living there, according to the Census. This includes money for Medicare Part B, children, health insurance, schools, nutrition, housing assistance, special education programs, head start, WIC, Title 1, foster care and many more. The number of people counted in each State also determines how many representatives they are entitled to in the US Congress. Florida gained 2 seats in 2010 and our population has grown since then.

Q. What if I have a home up north? Where do I complete the Census?

You determine your primary residence and complete the Census for that address. You can only complete the Census for one property address.

Q. How private are my responses?

Absolutely no personal data is released for 72 years following a Census. For example, information from the 1950 Census will first become available in 2022. No personal information is given to any other federal agency, such as the IRS or to immigration officials.













Q. Are only citizens counted?

No, we are counting every single person in this country and all should answer the Census questions.

Peridia representative: Thank you so much Neal. This has helped a lot.

Facebook Scams and Traffic Safety

The Better Business Bureau is warning about a new scam called "malicious tagging" that is targeting Facebook users. In recent months, several thousand users of the social media site have become victims of this threat.

It all begins when you get tagged in a Facebook post, along with some other Facebook friends. Since you see your friends are also tagged in the post — and in many cases, a friend of yours appears to have shared the post — you assume the link is safe. However, it turns out to be a link to an "adult" video, and when you click it, a pop-up window appears. You're prompted to download a Flash player update before watching the video, which is really malware.

The malware immediately scans your computer for personal and banking information and then perpetuates the scam, taking over your computer and creating another fake post with some of your friends tagged in it. The BBB outlines a number of steps to take when you suspect or are confronted with malicious tagging on Facebook, and in some case, when using Twitter.

1. Don't Click

The BBB warns against clicking on links that contain descriptions such as, "exclusive," "shocking" or "sensational" footage. If it sounds over-the-top, it's likely a scam.

2. Be Leery of Shortened Links

Scammers often use link-shortening sites to disguise malicious links. Don't fall for it. If you can't tell the destination of the link without clicking, there's a good chance it could lead you down the wrong path.

3. Don't Trust What Your Friends Post

The malicious tagging scam has impacted so many people because people assume that whatever their friends post is safe. However, you unfortunately can't be sure your friends' computer hasn't been hacked. Even when it appears your friend is "liking" or "retweeting" a link, it could also be part of a scam.

Speeding in our Neighborhood

As you know we are in the middle of 'season' and even though the 45th St. (or as some of us call it "I-45", project has been completed we are still getting a lot of cut-through traffic through Peridia, especially on Pro Am. Several residents have contacted me asking what we can do to get the drivers to slow down. All our streets are county roads not Peridia owned, so our Board does not have jurisdiction to place additional signage, patrol, etc. as some residents have inquired about. The Manatee Co. Sheriff's Dept. has told me they plan to install temporary electronic speed signs indicating the actual speed of the car in the future for a specific period of time, and hopefully can free up some resources to have a sheriff's car in the area at certain times during the day to give the speeders tickets. Our experience is that this has been done numerous times in the past, and only slows a few of the cars down, with most ignoring them. Please use extra caution when walking/crossing, pulling out, biking etc. on Pro Am. Because fire and rescue also utilize us as a cut-through sometimes due to the heavy traffic on SR70, also coming into Peridia as needed to help our residents, they will not install speed breakers. They are also aware of the speeders on 44th and 45th and have set up speed traps at certain times, but their resources are stretched so thin due to the growth in our county, they can not always dedicate officers to help eliminate speeding. So, please be careful and if you can get a license plate number of a speeder (which is almost impossible to do), please call the traffic hotline number that is located on page 2 of the Peridia Resident Directory, which is available in the office.

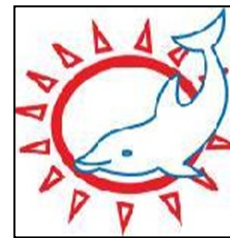
