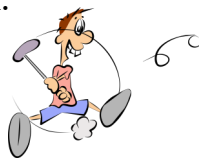

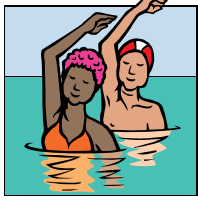

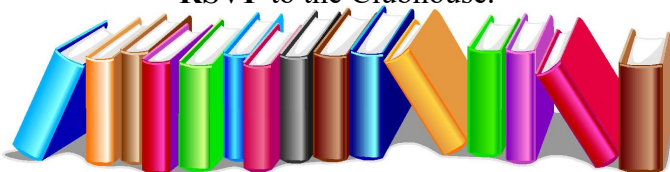

General Manager's Corner

HAPPY NEW YEAR

The staff (all 53 employees and 31 volunteers) wanted me to thank all of you that contributed to the Employee Holiday Fund this year. A BIG THANK YOU TO ALL WHO CONTRIBUTED.

December was a very busy month with our golf rounds exceeding the anticipated rounds by 175 rounds and Food and Beverage out performing our December budget. Overall, we ended the year on a positive note. I am expecting that 2022 will be even stronger, with more people discovering Peridia as their home away from home.

The face lift in the cart staging area is scheduled to start January 3rd by removing the old shrubs and the old wood bulkhead. The contractor has laid out the boundary lines for the new bulkhead which will add about 1,000 square feet to the area and give us a lot more room for our carts. The concrete work for the cart staging area will be started shortly after the completion of the new bulkhead. In order to accomplish all of this work the bridge will be closed for a couple of weeks and the carts will be routed to the west side of the 18th green and continue around the pond back to the cart barn.

Our 4 pickleball courts have been very busy these last 2 months and I am expecting them to get even busier. On January 29th there will be a pickleball court grand opening from 11:00AM to 1:00PM which will include a pickleball clinic to help introduce the game to those members that are curious to know more about the game. 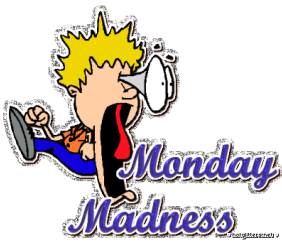

Online Security and Other Safety Related Info

Happy New Year to everyone – 2022 WOW, where does the time go? I hope everyone had a great holiday. I know that we did. Now, getting those holiday decorations down is never as much fun as putting them up!

Most likely our private info is already on the web, in some form or fashion, but computer-savvy criminals seem to stay at least 10 steps ahead of us protecting our information. It seems every day someone's account on Fb or other social media sites is being hacked. One of the best ways to minimize the chance of criminals getting their hands on your data is to change your passwords more often. I know.....this is a time-consuming endeavor, but the experts highly recommend it. Start fresh and update all your passwords at one time, and then schedule it to be re-done in 6 months. Never use the same password twice and make them more complex. If a hacker tries a password on one of your accounts, they will try it on other accounts. Make sure that you write them down somewhere and keep them in a non-obvious place in your house. There are online password manager services like Dashlane, or 1Password. They store your passwords and logins in a truly secure place in the cloud, so you don't have to remember them. Some people feel more secure by having a two-step verification to enter your accounts which you can set up through your personal settings on the computer.

Traffic is a hoot (as we say in the South) and it's not going to get any better. But the ongoing construction in our area seems to never end. The completion of the I-75 ramp work at SR70 that was to end originally in August has been extended until after the first of the year. Same with the road work in the Morgan Johnson Road/44th Street extension. Next up they will be starting the revamping of the exit ramps at I-75 and 301 which will be a mess for sure!

We have not had any criminal activity that has been reported since my last column; however, recently on Pro Am Ave late at night a neighbor was taking their dog out and saw a man 'jogging' in the road, and this person immediately ran through a yard and headed towards Kilty and hopefully out of the neighborhood. Please, please, if you see anything of this nature, call 911 and report it. Anytime we have an opportunity to prevent a car from being broken into, or vandalism occurring, as well as any other criminal activity from happening we should act immediately by calling the Sheriff's Department. Let's help keep each other safe!!!!

From Golf Advisory Committee

It has been called to the attention of the Golf Committee that there is a problem regarding the use of the golf carts. There is an abuse of the Handicap Blue Flags, which has in turn become an abuse of the golf course.

This problem with the use or the abuse of the handicap flags is not unique to Peridia Golf and Country Club. It is an issue that has been around a long time, but it would be wrong for the Golf Staff as well as the Golf Committee to continue to ignore the problem. The problem has grown to the point that the grass on some of the tees, has been damaged by the carts being parked on the side of the tees. Carts are being driven between sand traps and the green. Carts are being parked on the sidewalk along the 17th tee. This all needs to stop.

The members are the guardians of the golf course, and change must start with the membership. We need to be reminded that we already have a local rule that no cart can be parked on the tee or the side of the tee. Carts are to remain on the cart path at the tee boxes. Handicap carts are given more flexibility around the greens, however at no time can a cart be on the edge of the green or between the green and any hazard. This coming summer when the cart paths are repaired, there is a possibility of adding additional cart paths around the 7th and 8th tees.

Research has shown that Peridia can stop renting a cart to any violator. This would be the last resort, however it's the only recourse left if someone refuses to respect the course and the course rules. The Staff and Golf Committee want the course to be the best it can be as well as everyone have a good time.

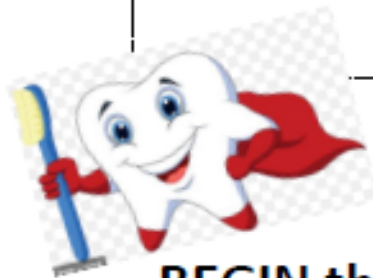
