

General Manager's Corner

HAPPY NEW YEAR 📜

It's party time at Peridia with many fun events planned. Let's start with our Tiki Bar; we will have entertainment each Saturday and Sunday from 3 to 5, weather permitting. Also, our Tiki Bar will now be open until 8:00PM each night with nightly specials between 6:00 - 8:00PM. Our first special for the month of January will be "buy one appetizer and get ½ off on any drink". Another change for this month will be Wednesday night dinners. We have been cutting off reservations when the dining room is full. We are going to experiment with taking reservations for inside and outside at pool side tables. We were filling up at 120 each Wednesday night, now we will be able to take our reservation count to about 200. I look for this to be a big night for the Club once the weather returns to normal.

As we go to press today, our total paid golf rounds have gone over 38,000. That is an increase of 3,200 rounds from 2021. We also average 13 employee rounds per day which brings our total rounds for the year to 43,000 rounds. Our goal for 2023 is to grow our rounds by 2,000 paid rounds.

Our new landscaping company for the Club and the common areas is FLC Property Maintenance. They have been in business since 1999 and have a 4-star rating. I am looking forward to working with this company in 2023 to bring our landscaping back to where it was in 2021. There is a lot of work to be done, but I think it can happen.

We have had reports of members continuing to feed the Canada Geese on the golf course. Please do not feed any form of animal on our golf course. The geese think you are welcoming them back from their summer retreat and believe me, we are not. They create issues for Ray and his maintenance staff.

I would like to remind our members that bringing your own alcohol on to Peridia property can result in the Club losing its liquor license. Yes, you read that correctly ... the Club can lose its liquor license if our members and guest bring their own alcohol to the golf course, tiki bar, tennis court area and the Clubhouse. This is a serious offense against our Rules and Regulations. Violating this rule can lead to a lengthy suspension from using any of the Club facilities.

The employees of Peridia wanted me to THANK each of you that contributed to the Peridia Employee Holiday Fund. It was a very nice Christmas!

Remember, I always have time for your questions or comments, so please stop by my office, my door is always open.

- Business and professional experience.
- Peridia and community activities in which you are involved.
- What can you contribute to the Master Board of Directors and the Peridia community.

Voting for these positions will take place at the Annual Meeting of the individual Component Associations. Results will be announced at the Peridia Property Owners Association, Inc. Annual Meeting, April 10, 2023.

Submit your resume no later than January 15, 2023 to the Peridia Business Office.

At the Master Board meeting on November 28, the operating and capital budgets for 2023 were both passed unanimously.

The operating budget for next year totals \$5,005,683. Yes, we are now a five million dollar a year business. The budget contains an increase in our dues of \$38.00 per quarter. We, like everyone else, were a victim of inflation and rising wages. But I assure you that the Board and the Finance Committee did everything possible to minimize the increase. The new number for dues represents a 4.4% increase.

The capital budget totals \$419,245. It has money available for any equipment that might need to be replaced. It contains funds for landscaping, lake bank restoration and cart path repairs. There is also money available for two items that should be of interest to everyone.

First, we plan to do an upgrade of our point of sale system. The updated equipment will include the purchase of hand held devices which will allow the wait staff to enter orders which will wirelessly go to the kitchen or drink station. Payment may be made at the table and a receipt can be printed from a printer on the server's waist.

Secondly, we will be improving the sound system at the Club. This upgrade should improve the acoustics both within the Clubhouse and in the Tiki Bar area.

As always, to meet our budget we need everyone's help in USING THE CLUB.


