

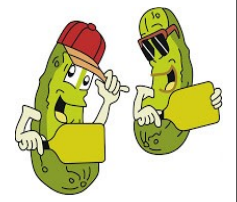
From the Golf Course Superintendent By Raymond Bartels, CGCS

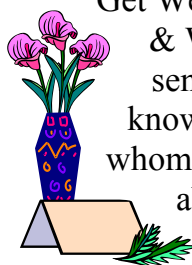

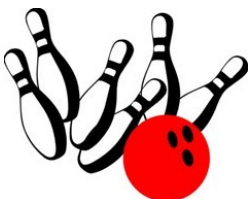

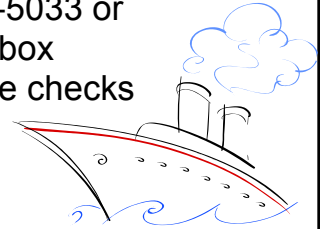
