

President's Blog

It's 2018. Once again, Peridia Golf and Country Club has the holiday spirit. The decorations at the Club were beautiful especially the tree in the front entrance. Houses were decorated throughout the neighborhood. What a great kick off to the New Year!

Opportunities and activities for your continued entertainment are posted in the January Scorecard. Emails are sent out every day to entice you to use your Club. Please make the time to relish the Peridia experience on the golf course, tennis courts, in the Golf Shop, restaurant, or around the pool. That's where you'll have the most fun. It's our Club. Let's use it.

Numerous projects are planned for 2018. There will be some temporary inconveniences for permanent improvements. We plan to utilize the off-season during the summer to accomplish much of the work.



- 1. The lake at tee box 12 and the lake of north of tee box 15 will be refurbished.
- 2. The filtration system, the weir, at the eastern lake off Pro Am Ave will be rebuilt. We are in the process of getting bids and scheduling it for February as we were given 60 days to complete the project by the Southwest Florida Water Management District.
- 3. ASAP, restaurant tables, chairs, carpeting, and window dressings will be selected for replacement by the summer.
- 4. Members have been concerned about the appearance of our Peridia bathrooms. Six of them will get new fixtures, floors, and a paint job.
- 5. Beginning in June, we will replace the 30-year timeworn irrigation system with one that will function fully with our computerized pump house. The new technology it brings to our course will enhance the course's looks and playability.
- 6. Only the main entrance of our parking lot will be repaved, as we don't have sufficient capital to replace it all. Hopefully in the future we'll be able to replace the areas being damaged by the roots of the huge oak trees.
- 7. We will also replace some needed kitchen and golf course equipment.

We advertise Peridia as the Premiere Executive Golf and Country Club in Bradenton, Florida. These renovations will help reinforce that reputation. More importantly, members have invested in Peridia every year. It's therefore appropriate that they have the opportunity to enjoy the facelifts as much as possible.

Skimmers at Gas Stations and Recent Equifax Breach

- There have been numerous reports of skimmers being placed at gas pumps in Manatee and Sarasota counties. Please take the following steps to avoid skimmers at gas stations:
- Pay in cash inside the store to ensure credit card information stays safe.
- Check to make sure the gas pump dispenser cabinet is closed and has not been tampered with.
- Use a gas pump closer to the front of the store. Thieves often place skimmers at the gas pumps farther away from the store.
- Use a credit card instead of a debit card. Credit cards have better fraud protection, and the money is not deducted immediately from an account.
- If using a debit card at the pump, choose to run it as a credit card instead of putting a PIN number in. That way, the PIN number is safe.
- Monitor bank accounts regularly to spot any unauthorized charges.
- Consumers who suspect their credit card number has been compromised should report it immediately to authorities and their credit card company.

Ring, ring. "This is Equifax calling to verify your account information." Stop. Don't tell them anything. They're not from Equifax. It's a scam. Equifax will not call you out of the blue. That's just one scam you might see after Equifax's recent data breach. Other calls might try to trick you into giving your personal information. Here are some tips for recognizing and preventing phone scams and imposter scams:

- **Don't give personal information.** Don't provide any personal or financial information unless you've initiated the call and it's to a phone number you know is correct.
- **Don't trust caller ID.** Scammers can spoof their numbers so it looks like they are calling from a particular company, even when they're not.
- If you get a robocall, hang up. Don't press 1 to speak to a live operator or any other key to take your number off the list. If you respond by pressing any number, it will probably just lead to more robocalls.

If you've already received a call that you think is fake, report it to the FTC.
