
From the Golf Pro Shop By PGA Head Pro Mitch Riley

We do have Gatorade and water available in the Golf Shop so please make sure you have plenty with you before you head out on the Links.

Our Maintenance Season is well under way, so make sure you stop by the Golf Shop to note the dates and times for aerification during the summer months. Ray and his staff continue to do a great job in keeping Peridia in tip top shape. Thanks Ray!!!



General Manager's Column

Yes, these are the lazy days of summer but not for this hard working Peridia staff! We are all hard at work cleaning, pressure washing, gardening, painting, laying concrete, cutting trees, refinishing wood floors and catching up on our filing. August 28 thru September 2, we will be closing for 6 days to deep clean the kitchen, the back dock area, the bar area and both the Palm room and the Rose room. We are just getting ready for our first wave of members coming back from their northern migration to their nice clean retreat.

Mitch and his staff have been doing a good job in getting outside play this year, the rounds of golf are up by 960 over last year at this same time. Free wings Thursday and Saturday has been a big part of the additional rounds. Our "play 5 get the 6th round free" has brought back players who have forgotten about Peridia until they find their Peridia card in their back pocket. That's when they realize that they are only two plays away from getting their free round. It has helped to bring them back.

Each summer I like to take an area and rejuvenate it with new landscaping but not this year due to the irrigation system out on Peridia Blvd. The system has been coming apart for the last five months and the repairs are starting to add up, we are at \$6,000 to date. I have a drilling company coming in to bore a 2 inch sleeve down the middle of Peridia Blvd. which will cost us another \$2,200. Once we get the 2 inch sleeve in, then we can run a new irrigation line down Peridia Blvd. and have water for all of the islands.

I met with Michelle Atkinson from the University of Florida about the type of plants to put in the west pond on Pro Am. She gave a presentation on aquatic plants that are suitable for prevention of erosion and improving the water quality of that pond at the June BOD meeting: I hope you had a chance to attend that meeting.

From the Pro Shop...Nathan has moved back up north to his home in PA. So Mitch has been looking to replace Nate and has found two candidates that are interested in coming to work for Peridia. Mitch has interviewed both and now his plan is to bring one of them on board by the middle of July.

Our new sand traps are working just like Ray designed them to work. You will see Ray working around the Golf Course with a big smile on his face. He is so happy to see that with all the rain we have had this past month that not one sand trap held water and not one trap had a wash out. Ray is scheduled to punch holes in the greens July 11. Get with the Pro Shop so that they can get you a tee time at one of the reciprocal courses we have on our list. The greens should be in good shape again by the July 15.

July and August are the two slow months for our Terrace on the Green. We will be doing a lot of specials on Wednesday and Thursday nights during that time so read your Scorecard and mark your calendars...and please buckle up your seat belts because you never know what the crazy General Manager has up his sleeves as last minute GM specials.

Remember, I always have time for your questions or comments, so please stop by my office. My door is always open.

Situational Awareness Tips to keep you Safe By: Pam Wallace, Chairman, Crimewatch Committee

In the summer months, statistics show that there is an increase in vehicle thefts especially in public places, especially parking garages and airport parking lots and an increase in personal thefts/attacks while walking/jogging. Below are a few tips to keep you safer.

While in or around your vehicle:


- Take your keys. Nearly 20 percent of all vehicles stolen have the keys in them.
- Lock your car. Approximately 50 percent of all vehicles stolen are left unlocked.
- Park in a well-lit and well-traveled area. When possible, park in a lot that has an attendant.
- Never leave valuables on your seat, the floor or the dashboard. Use the trunk and glove compartment for storage.
- Know your keyless entry settings. Keyless technology is convenient, but this technology can leave your vehicle vulnerable. Lock your doors while pumping gas and ensure your keyless entry fob proximity settings are set appropriately.

When walking:

- Walk with your head up, make eye contact with others, have confidence and move at a steady pace.
- Stay in well-lit, heavily traveled areas. Avoid alleys, dark parking lots or secluded areas.
- If you wear headphones while walking, keep the volume low so you can hear other noises.
- Avoid texting and walking, and remain aware of where you are going and who is coming toward you.
- Don't walk alone at night. Walk in groups as there is safety in numbers.
- If you are going to a particular destination, let someone know you are on your way and approximately what time you will arrive.
- If you are carrying a wallet, keep it in your purse or bag and carry it close to your body. Do not leave personal items unattended at any time.
- Vary your route and time. Take a different path so you don't become predictable.

Are you going out of town and would like to have extra patrols from the Sheriff's Office? We offer as a courtesy to our residents a patrol request function from our patrol deputies. Simply call the non-emergency number for the Sheriff's Office at (941) 747-3011 Ext. 2260 and ask for a patrol request while you are gone. You will be asked to give the dates that you will be gone, your address, and your contact information should we need it. This will alert our deputies to conduct extra patrols at your home while you are gone.

Volunteers may be asked to:





BEAWARE! HURRICANE SEASON RUNS PROM JUNE 1 TO NOVEMBER 30

Peaking from mid-August to late October. During that time, six hurricanes will form in the Atlantic Ocean, Caribbean Sea, or Gulf of Mexico and two hurricanes will form in the Central Pacific Ocean.

BE Prepared...

Create an Evacuation Plan: If you need to evacuate, know your evacuation zone.

Also go to a family member's home or a public shelter outside of the evacuation zone. Be sure to consider your pets when developing your plan, as most local shelters do NOT allow pets.

Put together a Hurricane Kit...

Stockpile enough water, non-perishable food (and a can opener) and medicine to last everyone in your household (including your pets) for at least one week. You'll also need clothing, blankets, flashlights, batteries, a hand-cranked radio.


Review your Insurance Policies...

Call your insuance agent or company to check whether you have enough homeowners insurance as standard homeowner's insurance doesn't cover weather-related flooding. Also your wind damage coverage. Review your car insurance and boat insurance policies as well.

Take pictures of your property...

Photograph all four sides of your home's exterior, as well as any other structures covered by your home insurance policy, such as your screen enclosures. They will be extremely helpful if you have to file an insurance claim for hurricane damage.
