This is the time of year for heat strokes and one cause of this is dehydration. We do have Gatorade and water available in the Golf Shop so please make sure you have plenty with you before you head out on the Links.

The irrigation project for the summer has started on holes 10-18. Because of this, only holes 1-9 are currently open for play. We have implemented a two-flag placement on the greens to simulate an 18-hole round. One flag is red and the other is blue. Once the backside irrigation is completed, they will go right into the front side. Ray and his staff continue to do a great job in keeping Peridia in tip-top shape. Thanks Ray!!!

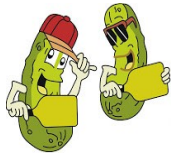

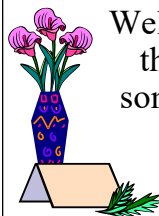

## General Manager's Column

This summer is going to be very busy one with the new irrigation system going in on the Golf Course and the renovation of the Clubhouse.

Mondragon started working on the new irrigation system on June 11 with their initial staging. On June 13 they laid out holes 10, 11, 12 and on June 15 they started to fuse the pipe together. On June 19 the first pipe went in the trench on hole #10. They are about a week behind schedule but are saying that they will catch up within the next week or two by adding 20 additional workers when they finish their project in St. Pete. This construction will take approximately 16 weeks.

Due to the irrigation project our summer maintenance program has changed. The herbicide applications to kill mole crickets and nematodes have been delayed and the aerification of the greens has been delayed by 30 days. The way we maintain the Course mowing program has not changed but the golfer is seeing the maintenance crew more often since the golfer is playing 18 holes on a 9-hole course. This means that the golfer will see the mowing crew twice during their round of golf. Please be patient while we are under construction.

The Club House committee has had their third meeting with Fawley Bryant. At this meeting the committee finalized the selection of fabric for the dining room chairs. The chairs have now been ordered, they will be built and delivered in 9 to 11 weeks. The committee gave us a peek at the carpet, chairs, fabric and flooring at the last BOD meeting. Everyone was very positive about the selections. The BOD gave their approval to lower the raised area of the Clubhouse so that the entire Clubhouse will be on one level. The lowering of the raised floor is as a result of recommendations by the design company and the remodel committee. The price for lowering the elevated flooring will be \$13,860, which was included in our \$285,500 remodel budget. The BOD also approved the added cost in taking the popcorn ceiling off the soffit area of the clubhouse. This soffit cannot be cleaned or painted because of the material. The cost to do replace the soffit, which includes the removal of the material, finishing the drywall with a smooth finish, painting and cleanup is an additional \$11,400 to the budget of \$285,500. If everyone can take a minute to stop and look at the soffit you will have a better idea of how dirty it is and a better understanding of the lack of ways to clean it.

Although the Clubhouse will be closed from August 20 through approximately September 11 for the Clubhouse renovation. we will keep the Tiki Bar open. We will send e-mail blasts to keep you informed of the hours of operation and the many drink specials.

Remember, I always have time for your questions or comments, so please stop by my office. My door is always open.

## **Staying Safe during the Summer Months**

Good news is that Manatee Co. Sheriff's Dept. reports that car thefts and burglaries from vehicles is down considerably due to their increased patrols and task force that has been working diligently to address this issue. They still encourage everyone to remain vigilant and remove all valuables and lock your vehicles. Also, they have increased patrols in the evening hours and have reported garage doors remaining open. They recently observed several in Peridia during the late-night hours and stopped and alerted the homeowners who did not realize their garage door had been left up. Also, if you see your neighbor's garage door left open during late night hours, please let them know. I think they would appreciate it, I know that I would.

Now that summer is here the temperatures are on the way up, and the humidity is high. Many of us enjoy different types of exercise, whether it be golf, aerobics, pickleball, swimming or other activities which are good for us; however, for those people who have recently re-located to our area and as a reminder to us that have been here a while, it is important to stay hydrated, especially during the hotter months.

Dehydration occurs when your body doesn't have enough water and other fluids to function normally. Dehydration can happen to anyone, but it is a problem that is more common in people who are older. ... As you age, your sense of thirst lessens, and the kidney isn't able to conserve body water as well. Symptoms and Signs of Dehydration in Adults includes: Increased thirst, dry mouth, tired or sleepy, decreased urine output, headache, and dizziness. Hydrate before, during and after all activities. If you think you are becoming over-heated or see someone that may be experiencing heat stroke, please render aid and call 911. If possible, get the person to a cool area and apply wet towels to their neck and head while awaiting professional help.

Summer season brings many visitors to Peridia, including children that will be playing and walking on our sidewalks and visiting our pool areas. Make sure that when walking your pets that they are on a leash and are not in close proximity to children or adults that are unknown to them. Even the best-behaved pet can be frightened by noise or activity that they are unaccustomed to and can over react by growling or biting.

We have had no crime reported within Peridia in the last two months. However, several residents have called to report individuals soliciting goods and services. We have "No Soliciting" signs posted at our entrance. We are a deed restricted community and have signs clearly posted. It does not make any difference that the roads are maintained by the county, we do not allow solicitation and please contact the sheriff's office if you have someone canvassing the neighborhood under the pretense of selling you something. Reputable companies do not solicit door to door.

Recipe of the Month

Coconut Flan

INGREDIENTS:

- 1-1/2 cups white sugar
- 1 (14 oz) can sweetened condensed milk
- 1 (12 fluid oz.) can evaporated milk

- 1/2 cup milk
- 6 eggs
- 1/2 cup fresh shredded coconut

PREPARATIONS: Preheat oven to 350° F

Place 1 cup of the sugar in a small saucepan over medium heat. Cook gently without stirring, but shaking occasionally until the sugar has melted. Continue cooking until the sugar has completely melted, and turned golden brown. Pour into a large glass baking dish. Spread the caramel evenly over the bottom of the dish, then set aside to cool for 15 minutes before proceeding.

Once the caramel has hardened, pour the condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk, eggs, 1/2 cup sugar, and coconut into a blender. Blend for 3 minutes until smooth. Pour into baking dish over the caramel.

Bake in preheated oven for 45 minutes until set. When done, remove from oven and let cool for 30 minutes. Run a knife around the edges of the dish to separate the flan from the sides. Refrigerate overnight.

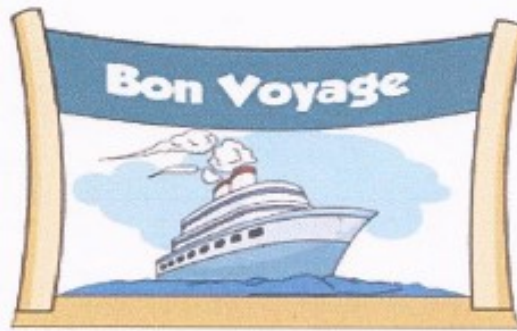
