For those members still here that play golf in the summertime, please make sure you stop in the Pro Shop to pick up your list of golf courses that we have a reciprocal agreement with. These are courses outside of Peridia that you can play for a discounted greens fee. Please make sure you look at each courses ground rules for making tee times.

General Manager's Corner

Since March our lives have been turned upside down with the COVID-19, it has become an obsession with all of us. We hear about it and see it on every news outlet from the time we get up in the morning until the time we go to bed. So, for those of you who are ready to get back out and socialize, Peridia will re-open on June 6^{th} for it's Coming Out Party! Open to the first 76 (based on 50% Occupancy) who sign up for the event. To help you feel more comfortable with coming to the Club, we have instituted the following list of precautions:

- 1. All guests will have their temperature checked before entering the Clubhouse. 100 degrees or less.
- 2. There will be hand sanitizers at the front doors.
- 3. Tables and chairs will be sanitized before and after each use.
- 4. Menus will be disposables, thrown away after order is taken.
- 5. All condiments are disposable.
- 6. We ask that as members you will try to observe the social distancing of at least 6 feet.
- 7. Staff's temperature will be taken at the beginning of each shift and no one will be allowed to work with a temperature over 100 degrees.
- 8. Staff will wear masks during service.
- 9. The preferred transactions will be by credit card or member account, NO CASH transactions please.
- 10. Guests and staff will have restricted interaction during payment process.
- 11. Bathrooms will be sanitized every 15 minutes.

We will start sitting the dining room starting on June 6th by reservations only. There will be NO bar service, all alcoholic beverages will only be served at your table. Due to the social distancing we will limit all reservations to a maximum of 8 people to a table. We are planning to continue our to -go program through June.



Storm Preparation and Debris Management

Hurricane Season begins June 1st. Since we have a lot of new residents, I wanted to share the following information from the Manatee County Utilities Dept.

During a storm, items in the yard, lawn furniture, tools, flower pots, etc. can become projectiles that could injure people and cause damage to buildings and automobiles. Removing those items ahead of a storm can help reduce damage and/or injury to others. If the storm impacts our area you may have debris. Trimming trees and getting rid of unwanted, broken or excess items now will reduce the amount of debris you will have to deal with after a storm. Preparing early means that the items are collected well before a storm nears. When conditions are deemed unsafe, garbage collection will be suspended leaving late-placed items uncollected at the curb. Do not leave garbage cans and recycling carts at the curb when a storm is approaching. Bring all cans and carts inside your garage where they should be stored at all times, regardless of a storm. Also, as a reminder, these items are not permitted to be left in your yard, beside your house, etc., unless they are in an area that is not visible from the street, golf course, or can not be seen by your neighbors. If Manatee Co. implements their Debris Management Plan, special collection trucks and schedules will be utilized. Do not bag debris. Do not place it on top of mailboxes, storm drains, or water

meters. Do not mix debris types. Complete clean up as soon as possible and comply with collection deadlines. Debris should be separated as follows: Vegetative (trees, limbs, leaves). Construction & Demolition (roofing material, metal, cement, fencing, screening). Appliances and White Goods (empty refrigerators, etc.), Garbage: (household furniture, mattresses, spoiled food, etc.). The collection process can be lengthy. Please be patient. 
