This is the time for our maintenance season to kick in as well, so please make sure you look at the schedule posted in the pro shop for closure dates and times.

The golf course will be closed Thursdays from May 27<sup>th</sup> through September. The PMGA and PLGA will stay at a 8:30AM shotgun start on Tuesdays and Wednesdays through the summer. 9 & Dine will start back the first week of October. Please call the Pro Shop if you have any question.

For those members still here that play golf in the summertime, please make sure you stop in the Pro Shop to pick up your list of golf courses that we have a reciprocal agreement with. These are courses outside of Peridia that you can play for a discounted greens fee. Please make sure you look at each course's ground rules for making tee times.

### **General Manager's Corner**

The CDC has lifted the mask requirements for vaccinated members and staff has brought a change to Peridia's requirements. Peridia will no longer require those using the Clubhouse, Tiki Bar, pool, tennis or Pickleball courts, Terrace on the Green and Pro Shop to wear a mask. Those of you that feel more comfortable wearing a mask at this time please do so, but please do not confront those who are not wearing a mask.

We planted 18 Foxtail Palm Trees this last month, 9 trees went on hole #10, 5 trees on the back side of the tee box and 4 on the far side of the green. We planted a replacement tree on #7 green, 5 trees a long side the tennis courts and 3 in the medium strips on the corner of Peridia Blvd. and Pro Am Ave. They look great!

Our Contractor, Mondragon ordered the lumber for the two bulk heads on holes #3 and #4 about 7 weeks ago, unfortunately the order has not yet been received. As soon as it comes in Mondragon will start replacing the old with the new. Their plan is to start with the bulkhead on hole #4 and after completing #4 they will start on hole #3. The bulk head on hole #4 will have the same design as it does now. The bulk head around #3 green will be raised to the same height as #3 fairway. We are planning to carry the height of the bulkhead from that fairway all away around to the left side of the green ending it at the backside of the green. This will help soften the steep slope on the left side of that green allowing a more gradual decline from the green to the bulk head. It will also make it safer on that left side of the green, when walking down to your ball. During the construction of the bulkhead on hole #3 we will have a temporary green cut into the fairway which will change the hole to a par 3 for the duration of the project.

Update on the Weir project... We now have a permit which was issued by SWFWMD allowing us to take out the filtering system for the weir on #10 lake, cut an opening into the top of the weir and attach a baffle to the top of that weir. I have met with Mark Adler from George Young Engineering to plan and schedule the work for the weir changes to meet SWFWMD requirements. This work is to be completed by June 16, 2021. I am in the process of contacting contractors to obtain bids for the project.

Please remember that the golf course and clubhouse will be closed on Thursdays and will re-open on October 7th. The office <u>will be</u> open during their normal business hours on Thursdays. I asked Tom Donato sometime ago about how many trees he thought we had lost on the Peridia property since he became General Manager. His answer was at least 50 and maybe more.

The planting of new trees has occurred regularly over the last several years. It began with the planting of 11 foxtail palms on the Golf Course in 2017. Including that initial planting, there have now been 58 foxtail palms planted. If you were unaware of this, they can be found on the Golf Course on holes 2, 5, 7, 9, 10, 15, 16, 17 and 18. They may also be found in our parking lot, both inside and outside the Tiki Bar, along the tennis courts, and in the median on Peridia Blvd.

A large portion of the funding for these trees was donated. Money was given by the PMGA, the PLGA and all of our Homeowner's Associations. The remaining funds came from our capital reserves.


The foxtail palm is native to Australia. It is an adaptable, fast-growing specimen. Of great importance for us, easy maintenance is associated with this tree. It is self-cleaning which means that spent leaves die and drop from the tree as needed to facilitate new growth.

Recently, two trees were planted near the practice putting green. Those trees were the result of donations given for a memorial for Bob Dufresne. One is a Magnolia, and the other is a Starburst Clerodendrum. Those donations also covered the cost of one of the palms in the median. This project was carried out under the able leadership of Karen Vowles.

With all the recent landscaping and new trees, Peridia is now even more beautiful!


