General Manager's Corner

Just a quick update on what is going on and what we are planning on accomplishing this summer.

Golf Course:

Our golf course survived all of the punching and stabbing that we gave it during the closing in May and is already returning a positive response.

The fairways were all punched with a 5/8 x 9-inch tine with 3 inch spacing. Each tine pulled a core of dirt at about 5 to 6 inches long. Ray and his guys then mowed the fairways 3 times to break up all of the cores and then went back and dragged the fairways with mats 3 more times. The fairways turned out just great. The whole golf course was fertilized right after the cleanup of the cores, so we should see quite an improvement in the amount of grass on the fairways and roughs this summer.

Our greens were punched with a 3/8 x 5-inch tine with 4 inch spacing. All of the cores were harvested and taken to areas of the course and used as fill dirt. With some rain and a little fertilizer those area will soon have grass. Ray and his guys sanded the greens with heavy top dressing which should result in beautiful greens in time for the Memorial Day tournament.

We added 6 pallets of sod to the east side of hole #7. Plans call for the use of a different style mower so that we can keep that area looking good.

All of trees on the golf course had their roots pruned during the course closing. This will help Ray to grow grass in some of the bare areas under the trees.

New cart paths went in on #7 and #8 tees. This should be a big help in getting to the back of the tee box on #7 with an easy in and straight shot out. The roundabout on #8 tee is just a simple in and simple out.

The entrance from the parking lot to the #1 tee box was widened in order to help eliminate the congestion that happens there during the season. This will also help us grow grass on the north side of that area now that there is plenty of room for two-way cart traffic.

Summer Projects:

- All of our lines in the parking lot will be painted.
- Four handicap parking spaces will be added at the south end of lot for easier access to Pool area.
- The exterior of the Club House, Pro shop and Cart Barn will be painted.
- The Peridia signs at all of our entrances will be painted.
- The curbing on Peridia Boulevard on both sides of Murfield Drive will be painted.
- The three speed tables and their approaches will be painted.
- The kitchen will be pressured washed and the walls and ceiling will be painted.
- New netting will be installed around our warm up cage.
- The area at the north end of the Pro Shop and Tennis Courts will be enhanced with additional landscaping.
- Rubber matting has been ordered for the area around the Pro Shop. Delivery is scheduled for some time in August.
- Brian is planning to detail all of our golf carts this off season.

Keep your fingers crossed on that one.

Preparing for Hurricane Season



Well, it is June already — Many of our neighbors have returned to their other homes and will not be returning until the fall. We will miss them until then and hopefully we will stay in contact until then. FYI in case you are not familiar with the Peridia Website, please contact Nancy in the office and obtain a log-in. The website address is: peridiagcc.net. You can keep up with what is going on while you are away. The Scorecards are posted there monthly, as are minutes from board meetings (if they are held in the summer months). But all Master Board meeting's minutes are posted, and our financial data is published there as well. Only Peridia residents can access this information.



Because we have so many new residents who are not familiar hurricanes and preparing for them, I wanted to offer some information that hopefully you will find useful. Early preparation is crucial to your safety, reduces the amount of post storm debris and ensures collection by Manatee Co. afterwards. If the previous residents did not maintain trees and other plantings, you need to make sure that is done now. Trees close to the house and lanai cage need to be trimmed back. If not, if a storm impacts our area, you can experience damage to your

roof, house, car, or lanai cage by fallen debris. Items in the yard and around the pool should be stored inside if you are going to be gone in the summer months and always if we are under a hurricane warning. Garbage collection will be suspended when winds are high and conditions unsafe. Do not leave garbage cans and recycling carts at the curb when a storm is approaching. If we do experience a storm special collection trucks and schedules will be utilized. Complete clean up as soon as possible and comply with collection deadlines. Do not bag debris. If you lose power the lift stations in our area may also not work and flushing toilets could cause sewage to back up. More information can be found at www.mymanatee.org/garbage You also can register for Alert Manatee which provides critical information regarding evacuations, shelters, hospitals, supplies and more. That website is www.mymanatee.org/alertmanatee Have water and other non-perishable food available and alcohol (ha) on hand to help ride out the storm. It is a good idea to have plenty of gas in your vehicle and some cash on hand in case of emergency!!!
