General Manager's Corner

The Golf Course maintenance work planned for the shutdown week was completed on schedule. Work began on May 10th with the aerification of the greens and tee boxes. On May 11th, Ray aerified the fairways and some rough areas. The greens and the tees were top dressed with sand and fertilizer and saturated with water to help fill in all the open holes. The cores from aerifying all 18 fairways were removed so as to make the fairways playable for the re-opening on May 22nd. As a result of a herbicide application the course turned a little brown but should be green again by next week. The installation of a new 36" pipe that SWFWMD required was installed from Lake #17 to Lake #18 across #6 fairway and completed in time for us to re-open the golf course this past week.

On a lighter note, our Mother's Day Brunch was a huge success with 379 adults and 19 kids attending. The Kentucky Derby event was also well received with 68 golfers participating in the tournament plus 70 additional members joining the golfers for the Derby party at the Clubhouse. There were finger food stations all around the Club where members were able to mingle with their fellow members while enjoying their favorite appetizer. The race went off right at 6:59 and 5 minutes later the lucky members with the winning tickets were standing at the wagering table collecting their winnings. The "All You Can Eat Seafood Fest" was held on Wednesday, May 31st and was another sold out event. Memorial Day golf and lunch was sold out with 94 golfers and a total of 130 for lunch. I am not sure if the trend that we are seeing will continue but since the beginning of 2023 every member event has sold out within a couple of hours of announcement. This is great for the Club but not so great if you forgot to call Mona on the day reservations begin. I have asked Nancy to look at our monthly calendar to see if we can fit a short reminder on the day that reservations open for member events. There are 1,250 members and we only have room for 7% at each event, so please pay attention to the event calendar so that you have a chance to attend our fun parties.

While the golf course was shut down for maintenance this past week, James, Frank and Tom painted the bridge and railing behind the number one tee. They were also able to re-paint the concrete in front of the Pro Shop. The wall on 45th St. is their next painting project – to begin this week. On a sad note, Frank has decided to move north and will be leaving us in early June. We wish him and his wife nothing but good fortune in their new venture.

Hurricane Season, Solicitors, Fishing in our lakes, Walking/Standing/Parking on street and looking out for your Neighbors!

Hurricane Season is just around the corner. Last year Ian created death, destruction of property and billions of dollars in losses to SW Florida. Fortunately, we escaped the worst of it but came very close to the eye of the storm. It can be very worrisome but being prepared helps alleviate last minute chaos with regards to securing your home, purchasing necessary tools, batteries, storm window coverings, food that does not require refrigeration and water. So, if you have not already done so, purchase these items. The first storm that shows up close to Africa will result in bottled water shortages!!!! Houses built before 2002 were built to sustain 110 mph winds. The code has since been amended to sustain higher winds, but Peridia homes were all built before 2002 except for one. Knowing your Evacuation Level is also very important. This can be found on the mymanatee.org website under emergency services, hurricane preparedness. If you cannot locate it, call 311 and give them your address. Evacuation levels are not the same as flood zones. Most of Peridia is under Evacuation Level D except for Wedge Court and the lower part of Pro Am towards 45th St which is in Evacuation Level B. The nearest evacuation shelter is Oneco Elementary and the nearest pet friendly shelter is Braden River High School. All pets must be in cages and have proof of up-to-date vaccinations and people with pets are kept in a separate area than the general public. If you have questions concerning hurricane shutters on your home, contact your HOA for specific information.

Solicitors continue to be a pain in the 'you know what'. Don't open the door to them. If you are in your garage or outside on your property and they approach you, tell them you are not interested and ask them to leave your property. Do not challenge them. If they persist and you feel threatened call 911. While we do have 'no soliciting' signs at our main entrance, it does not deter them.

Every summer we have instances where non-members come into Peridia and fish in our ponds. If you suspect that is happening, contact our General Manager, do not approach them. Fishing is 'catch and release' and only open to our members and their families.

There is a Manatee County Ordinance that prohibits people/pets from walking/standing/parking in the streets. Our roads are County Roads so this is not allowed, nor is it safe. Several complaints have been filed with Code Enforcement by people observing residents walking their pets in the streets where the asphalt gets very hot quickly as the temperatures continue to reach into the high 90's and more in the summer months. Not only is it unsafe and very unreasonable, but it can also burn your pet's paws and should be avoided at all costs. All our streets have sidewalks and there are common areas to walk your pets. Please remember to clean up after your pet. Cars parked on the street must be moved every 24 hours or are subject to being ticketed.

Lastly, recently a resident fell and was unable to get up for several days, only to be found by a relative who had been unable to reach them. The resident survived, but if you know someone that lives alone, make sure someone is checking in with them every day just to say hello and know they are safe.
