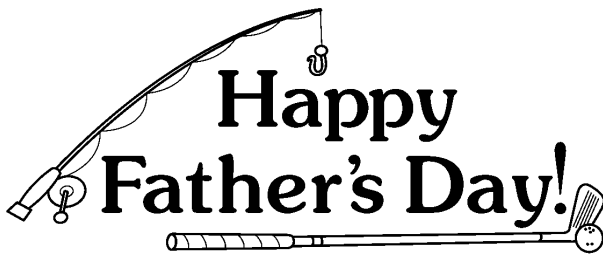

For those members still here that play golf in the summertime, please make sure you stop in the Golf Shop to pick up your list of golf courses that we have a reciprocal agreement with. These are courses outside of Peridia that you can play for a discounted green fee. Please make sure you look at each Course's ground rules for making tee times.

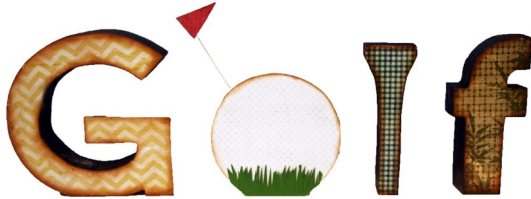

Our current software system does not have the ability to print the bar code.

General Manager's Column

Memorial Day Tournament had a great turnout; everyone enjoyed the golf and the COOL picnic that followed "IN THE CLUBHOUSE". The Fourth of July tournament will be held on July 3. Again we are expecting a big turnout so sign up early.

This month I thought I would give everyone an update on some of the projects that we are working on:

The sand trap project has been completed, the bulk head on 18 has been removed and the drainage issue on number 3 has been fixed. In addition to that work, the small bulkhead on 15 tee box has been removed, the drains around the Golf Course have been raised and the drain on the 15th hole has been repaired. There was a cost of \$1,600 to replace the drain on number 15 because the catch box below the surface grid is 4 feet deep and measures 5 feet by 5 feet. The old box had to be dug up and replaced with a new box. The cap on the bulk head on number 12 lake will be replaced later this summer.

Update on finding an Interior Designer... We started with replacing chairs and looking at new carpet and window dressings, with the idea of upgrading the kitchen at the same time. Well, the committee and I have started to interview architects that have design departments. We are trying to come up with an overall plan to enlarge the kitchen and the restaurant seating compactly. We have interviewed Terry Osborn from Osborn and Sharp, Mark Sultana from DSDG and Associates, and Amanda Parrish from Fawley and Bryant. All three are architectural companies in the area and all three have worked on country clubs in Florida. We are in the early stages of finding some options for the BOD to consider and give us some direction.

James has started his annual maintenance work on our mail boxes. You will see James out and about working on the boxes, and this will take a couple of weeks to complete. James is looking for an assistant now that Norm has left us for retirement. We will be pressure washing our buildings and our Peridia signs. The pool area deck will be getting a fresh coat of paint. The rubber squares flooring around the Pro Shop will be cleaned or replaced. We will be working to improve the looks of your assets so that you can be proud to invite your guests out to your Club for golf, tennis, lunch, dinner or just a beverage or two.

PHONE SCAMS AND MORE

I have received several calls from residents that have recently received SCAM phone calls. I talked about this in an earlier article, but I wanted to mention it once again. The most recent calls advise you that you will receive a summons and someone will be coming to your house unless you call them back to discuss the matter. They are persistent and will call you several times with the same message. While this is annoying, please rest assured it is a SCAM. These residents have reported it to the Manatee Co. Sheriff's office and they also have confirmed it is a SCAM. Please be mindful that if you are being served a summons for any reason, the court system or local authorities DO NOT call ahead to discuss this with you. The best way to avoid SCAM calls is to block the number from your phone (both house and cell phone). If you are a SPECTRUM customer, Go to Spectrum.com and sign in to "My Account" If you have not established an on-line account, do so and Sign in. Under PHONE you will choose "Manage Phone Features". Choose "Call Blocking" and enter the number you want blocked and click on Save. If you want to block a number from your cell phone, Google "How to block number on cell phone". Instructions on different type phones, (iPhone, Android, etc.) will appear and you can review the instructions necessary to block a number from your particular type phone. That way, you will have blocked the caller or callers from your cell phone permanently. I recommend that if you see an incoming call that you do not recognize, do not answer it. If it is a legitimate call, they will leave a message.

Coffee and Brown Sugar-Crusted Skirt Steak

Ingredients

- 1/4 c. finely ground espresso coffee (not instant)
- 1/4 c. dark brown sugar, firmly packed
- 1 1/2 tsp. Kosher salt
- 1/8 tsp. ground cinnamon
- 1/8 tsp. ground ginger
- 1/8 tsp. ground white pepper
- 1/8 tsp. five-spice powder
- Pinch cayenne pepper
- 2 1/2 lb. skirt steak, cut into 4 pieces
- 1 tbsp. olive oil

Directions

1. Heat grill to high.
2. Combine coffee, brown sugar, salt, cinnamon, ginger, white pepper, five-spice powder, and cayenne pepper in a bowl.
3. Remove steak from refrigerator and let come to room temperature, about 15 minutes. Rub steak with oil, and sprinkle with rub. Massage rub into meat.
4. Grill until charred and medium-rare, 2 to 4 minutes per side. Transfer to a cutting board, cover with foil and let rest 5 minutes before thinly slicing at an angle. Serve immediately.

This rub is equally good on chicken, pork chops, or salmon. Mmmmmm
