Happy June everyone!!!!The summer is already here and the hot weather is on the way. I hope that everyone enjoyed the winter season and had a chance to play in the great conditions we had at our Golf Course. A big thanks to Ray and his staff for the hard work. This is the time for our maintenance season to kick in as well, so please make sure you look at the schedule posted in the Golf Pro Shop for closure dates and times.

The Golf Course will be closed all Tuesdays through the summer. The PLGA will move to Wednesday mornings and will continue with a 8:30AM shotgun start. The PMGA will be a 8:00AM shotgun start on Wednesdays starting June 5th. Please call the Golf Pro Shop if you have any questions.

For those members still here that play golf in the summertime, please make sure you stop in the Golf Pro Shop to pick up your list of golf courses that we have a reciprocal agreement with. These are courses outside of Peridia that you can play for a discounted greens fee. Please make sure you look at each courses ground rules for making tee times.

Etiquette 101: This month I would like to talk about etiquette on the putting green. Players should not stand on another player's line of putt or, when he is making a stroke, cast a shadow over his line of putt. Players should remain on or close to the putting green until all other players in the group have holed out.

Golf Course Watch: This is the time of year we have more light in a day and people seem to find their way on the Course after hours. Please remember there shouldn't be anyone on the Course playing golf after the flags have been pulled.

Also since we're in the summer months please make sure to consume plenty of liquids. This is the time of year people get heat stroke due to being dehydrated. We do offer water and Gatorade in the Golf Pro Shop snack bar which will rehydrate you with the electrolyte content. Happy golfing!!!

Our first aerification on the greens went well. We punched the greens at 5/8" tines x 5" depth. This helped remove a lot of organic matter. This month I plan on applying another pre-emergent herbicide and fertilize the entire Golf Course again. We will continue with our weekly top dressing of the greens and spot spraying of the Golf Course. Sorry for any inconveniences our summer work brings, enjoy the Golf Course and I hope to see you out there.

General Manager's Corner

EXTRA, EXTRA READ ALL ABOUT IT!

Our Terrace On The Green Restaurant, Bar and our Tiki Bar are now closed all day on Tuesdays thru September 10th, re-opening on September 17th. On Thursdays, Our Terrace on The Green Restaurant will close right after lunch at 2:00PM which means there will be no dinner service. We will re-open on Thursday nights for dinner on September 17th. Our Bar and Tiki Bar will be open until their normal closing times.

Benefits of closing the Terrace On The Green for 17 weeks during the summer season:

- 1) We save \$32,160 on Clubhouse labor because we are closed for 17 weeks.
- 2) We save \$3,100 on Clubhouse cleaning contract during our Tuesday closings.
- 3) Additional miscellaneous savings on linen, electric, gas, cleaning supplies and so on is estimated around \$8,000.
- 4) So, by closing on Tuesday's all day and Thursday after 2 pm, we will see a savings in expenses of about \$43,000 over the 17 weeks.
- 5) Our total loss of revenue for that same time period will be about (\$10,200), so there is a savings of about \$30,000.

This past week James pressured washed the roofs of the Golf Course bathrooms and is in the process of painting the inside and the outside of both buildings. James and Frank formed and poured the concrete to widen the cart path next to the 17th tee. James will be working on changing out the light fixtures on our front signs on State Route 70. He will be replacing them with LED units to help brighten our entrance.

Ray aerified the greens on the May 16th, with 5/8 tines and pulled a 5-inch core. The cores were collected and placed in areas that had no grass next to the cart paths. On the 21st Ray had a company come in and put down a Curfew application on our fairways. This application is to reduce our mole crickets count and help Ray with growing grass in our fairways.

Chef Todd has started his new menus for both lunch and Wednesday nights. You will see on his new menus that he has a symbol for gluten free items. He has put together a nice selection of gluten free items for our members to enjoy.



Keep your eyes open for Carla and Larry's drink specials for this summer at the Tiki Bar. Every day they have \$1.00 off all drinks but I am hearing them talking about having some wild discounts at different times of the day. Keep reading your e-mails from Peridia's Tiki Bar.

Travel Tips and the latest Scam

Since the summer is here, I thought it would be helpful to share some travel safety tips. Whether you travel often or you're getting ready for a once-in-a-lifetime vacation, it's important to think about safety as part of your travel preparations.



Before you leave: Share your travel information. Before you leave, share your itinerary with someone you trust. Include the address and phone number of your accommodations and transportation information, like flight numbers.

- **Research ground transportation.** Research taxi and ridesharing companies that are available and reputable in the area. Do they take credit cards or only cash? Is there a number you can call if you have a bad experience? If you plan on taking public transportation, look for a mobile app that has real-time updates for the transportation system at your destination. This can help you avoid waiting for a bus in an isolated area.
- information provided by the cruise line and learn more about cruise ship safety before you board.
- Think about Plan B. It's not plausible to make a back-up plan for every situation but thinking through the following scenarios might prevent you from winding up in a tough spot.
 - Are you familiar with your surroundings? Take note of local landmarks, like drugstores or restaurants, that can help you feel more oriented. If something happens, you'll know where to turn for help.
 - If you get lost, do you have the address of your lodging written down or memorized in the local language?
 - If you are separated from the group, is there a designated place where they would go to look for you?
 - If your phone dies, do you have a portable backup charger and a few phone numbers memorized? If you're traveling out of the US, have you activated international service?
 - If you're planning on driving, do you have access to a map if your GPS doesn't work?
 - Do you know where the nearest hospital or police station is and how to contact them?

In an emergency abroad contact the US Dept. of State who can connect you with a variety of resources. From the US and Canada: 1-888-407-4747 and from Overseas: +1-202-501-4444

One of our residents recently received a call supposedly from their cell phone provider who posed as a representative from T Mobile. They called her cell phone from a 941 number and advised that someone had added a third line to their wireless account needed verification. As the conversation continued, the person seemed suspect to her, but they continued the conversation. Eventually, she questioned him further and he could not answer the questions to her satisfaction. She asked to speak to a supervisor and was connected to someone in the fraud dept. named Christopher who asked her to verify her PIN number and account number. He then changed the PIN number and proceeded to convince her to go access her account through the computer and set up a new account number. He now had everything he needed to stop her cell service which he did. The next morning, she contacted T Mobile and was advised they no longer had their account and the cell phone number. The scammers were also able to get into their credit card accounts and attempted to use them. Since they had all the info necessary to open a new account, the scammers had already requested new cards be sent to them. The resident contacted the bank immediately and was able to avoid any charges. However, the message here is to NEVER give any account information, PIN numbers, etc. to anyone calling. Hang up and call the company's phone number listed on your account and/or billing statement and report the call.


