## **General Manager's Corner**

#### No shows:

I think it is great that everyone wants to attend each member event but we are experiencing NO SHOWS at a number of sold-out events. NO SHOWS happen when you make a reservation and you do not call to let us know you that you are not attending the event. Staffing, food ordering and food preparations are determined based on the number of reservations. Most of our events sell out within the first 6 hours after we start taking reservations. When we sell out, Mona maintains a wait list of those wanting to attend the event. If you have made a reservation and subsequently determine that you cannot attend that event you must call to cancel your reservation. Mona will then replace that cancellation with a replacement from the wait list. That event will, therefore, remain a sell-out. This procedure will insure that there will be no empty seats for a "sold-out" event and an equal number from the wait list that did not attend the event. It also means that the Club will not have any uncollected revenue for those empty seats. Please be thoughtful when making your reservation, making sure that you are going to attend if you make a reservation and if you are not able to attend PLEASE CALL US TO CANCEL SO THAT SOMEONE ELSE CAN ATTEND.

#### **Course Closing:**

Our golf course was scheduled to close for maintenance on May 1, 2023. Due to a scheduling conflict we have moved the closing to May 10, 2023. On the 10th and 11th our deep core aerification will take place for the tees and greens. On the 16th, 17th, and if needed on the 18<sup>th</sup>, we will be aerifying the fairways and roughs. Ray will need two days to get the course ready for play, so we will re-open the course on the 20th.

#### January Revenue:

Our golf course was very busy during the month of January with 953 more rounds than in January, 2022. Our revenue was \$29,450 more than last January. Our numbers are showing that the 953 increase was divided almost equally between members and the public. It is good to see that more of our members are now playing golf. 2023 membership rounds are 43.5% of total rounds, up from 37% lat year. January, 2023 Food and Beverage revenue is up by \$38,575 over last January. We are seeing our member events all sell out, including many of our Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday nights. The Tiki bar is busy every day from 1pm to about 7pm, with members and golfers. We are continually looking at ways to help our staff to be more efficient and adding a new soda gun system to the Tiki bar and the Clubhouse bar will certainly help. Both Pepsi and Coke bid on installing the system and we awarded the business to Coke. Beginning in late March we will have Coke products on tap for our soda gun system.

#### **Scorecard Help:**

For 20+ years, Jim and Madeline Horvath have dedicated their time assembling our Scorecard newsletter so that the other volunteers could distribute. Jim and Madeline have decided that it is time for the Club to find a replacement. Their efforts have been very much appreciated and they will be greatly missed. We are asking if there are any volunteers who would help once a month to do this very important job. The assembly occurs at the end of each month and, with enough people, it only takes a few hours (and lunch is provided by the Club). Please stop by and see Nancy in the office or email her at admin@peridiagcc.net, letting her know that you would be happy to help.

#### **Streetlights:**

The streetlights out in front of your homes belong to FPL. When you have a light go out you will need to call FPL's service number (see page 1 of the Peridia Directory), give them your name and the number that is on the pole. They will replace the light within 40 to 60 days.

Just an update from the Golf Advisory Committee. People failing to show up for a reserved tee time in a league is becoming a problem for the Pro Shop, as well as the people that run the separate leagues. This time of year, when a morning tee time is \$55 and the afternoon tee time is \$45, a missed tee can mean a loss of up to \$220 for the Club not to mention the headache for the person that runs the league to adjust teams on the fly at the last minute.

It seems the question of cart abuse and lack of drivers following the basic golf cart standards is never ending. The carts need to try and remain on the concrete at the individual tees. We still have people leaving the concrete and going up on the tee boxes and the tee approaches. This has to stop, it is harmful to the grass and the sides of the tees. There is absolutely no reason for a cart to be parked on the sidewalk at the 17<sup>th</sup> Tee. The carts block the walk for the pedestrians and damages the grass area.
