General Manager's Corner

Rounds of golf for January were down by 175 from January 2020. The unusual cold weather in January was the main reason. We did beat budget by \$8,500. This was all because of our outside play. We are seeing about a 20% increase of our members walking this season. Part of that is because of the cart situation with two golfers to a cart and the fact that members are trying to get more exercise.

Our new Weekend Menu has been received with a lot of good comments coming back to my office. After two weeks we did change up a few items and we did add more gluten free options. Chef Todd and Judy are running reports each week to see what is and what is not selling. Those items that have no sales attached to their report are taken off the menu and replaced with new creations. The Weekend Menu, which is only available on the weekends, is for use at the Tiki Bar and for To-Go orders.

Our To-Go orders are still going strong, we are averaging 75 to 80 per day. The Chef continues to change up the entrée items on the menu during the week, giving our members something different to choose from each day. As a result of more frequent menu changes the Chef is purchasing in smaller quantities. To insure that each menu item is made fresh each day the Chef is physically visiting his vendors. This is a change to our business model which will be adjusted as we learn more about the membership needs. I think that this new business model will continue to evolve periodically until we get back to normal sometime in 2022 . Sorry Chef! 😊

Starting on March 14th the F&B operation will be providing food and drinks at the Tiki Bar from 11:00AM to 7:00PM each day of the week. Our inside Bar and Dining room will also be open for food and beverage until 7:00PM Monday thru Thursday and until 8:00PM on Friday nights.

Our open-air concept at the Tiki Bar has been such a big success that I need to add about five more tables on the east side of the bar. This move will reduce our total number of chase lounges in that area but I can place them around the pool so that we can accommodate the sun bathers during spring break. Our outside kitchen has been put on hold for 2021, this is because of the logistics of the project and the problems that we are having with finding adequate staffing.

Pickleball has collected \$615 in guest fees so far this year. That shows us that there is opportunity to grow the participation thru word of mouth and well-placed ads. A guest pays \$5 per day or \$25 for a monthly pass for the use of the court, so, there has been 98 guests playing on our courts since the 1st of January. Who said that no one will pay to play pickleball?

Update on our staff and covid-19 Only one member of the team has had the covid-19 and that was back in April of 2020. We continue to require our staff to provide a certificate showing a negative test result when coming back to work even if they only missed one day of work.

Remember, I always have time for your questions or comments, so please stop by my office. My door is always open.

If you build it, they will come. This phrase aptly describes what has happened at the Tiki Bar. Last summer the Tiki Bar area was greatly expanded and renovated. New tables, chairs and umbrellas were added, and the area now has seating for over 100. The GM is even considering adding a few more tables.

So Peridia built it, and you came. The number of members using the Tiki Bar since the renovation has been outstanding. On a typical good weather day, many members can be seen there. Now, every other Friday night entertainment has been implemented. After this policy began, on one Friday there were well over 100 patrons in attendance. The crowd was so large that many people had to go inside for seating.

Recently, a Weekend Menu was started. It is a reasonably extensive menu and probably will be changed slightly each month. The menu is available only at the Tiki Bar on Saturdays and Sundays from 11:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. It is also available on the same days and times for carry out.

All in all, the Tiki Bar has been a huge success since the renovation. Usage continues to grow. One of the easiest and most fun ways to USE THE CLUB is to go to the Tiki Bar.

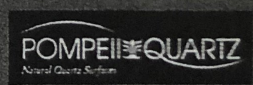
