



#### **General Manager's Corner**

This month I thought I would just give our members a short update on some of the projects that we are working on or have just completed:

#### **BEAUTIFICATION**

The two islands at the north end of Peridia Blvd. are getting a new face lift. Bloomings, Peridia's Landscape Contractor, is putting in new plantings and irrigation to freshen up the area. This cost will be part of the \$5,000 free plantings that we receive each year through our 3-year contract agreement with Bloomings. Our maintenance staff will also be painting the curb on both of those islands.

#### CART STAGING AREA

Now that the hand railing has been completed the cart staging area looks really nice. Eagle Golf worked the last two weekends to complete the job. There is a safety cone on top of the drain coming off the bridge. A cover has been ordered and as soon as it arrives I will have James finish placing the last piece of that puzzle.

#### SAND TRAPS

Mondragon Construction Company came in three weeks ago to work on improving our sand traps. They ended up placing 4 inches of new sand in all of the traps. They were out on the course during play and finished the project this past week. The traps look great.

#### LAKE BANK RESTORATION

American Shore Line finished restoring our lake banks surrounding our irrigation lake/driving range this past week. The lake banks look great. Along with the restoring of the lake banks ASL worked with the three of our HOA'S to help solve their drainage and erosion problems.

#### WEIR ON LAKE #10

Taking the dirt out of Lake #10 will start in about two weeks. The plan is to go down 12 inches below where the water level is now. The result will be that the lake bottom will not be visible.

#### PICKLEBALL CLINIC

The Pickleball clinic that took place on February 5<sup>th</sup> was a huge success! There were people everywhere, beginners learning how to play the game, groups that were playing to show what a game looks like, volunteers that were selling the raffle tickets and finally, ladies that were giving out the free hot dog fest tickets. We ended up with 130 people coming out to watch the exhibitions and they all came over to the Tiki Bar for hot dogs. The Pickleball Committee did a great job.


