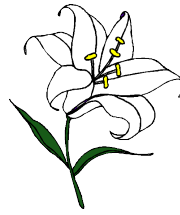

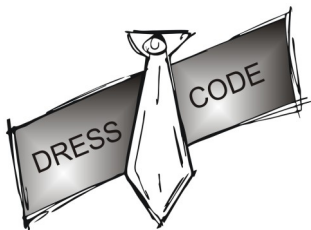
Happy March everyone. I hope you all enjoyed the great weather and course conditions for the month of February.

General Manager's Corner

UPDATES ON WHAT IS GOING ON AROUND THE CLUB

PARKING LOT LIGHTS:

Our parking lot has become a dangerous place to walk after dark. At the last Board meeting I reported that we were looking to take three trees down to allow more light to illuminate the parking lot. I went out and got two bids. The bid that I settled on was \$585 which includes stump grinding. I had the company take down one tree to see if it would make a difference and I am happy to say that it made a 100% improvement. The other two trees will be taken down soon.

TENNIS and PICKLEBALL COURTS:

Last month we discussed expanding the footprint by 12 feet and there was a push back from some of the Members. So, I called both Welsh Tennis and Taylor Tennis to come in and re-bid the job taking only the original foot print of the facility and splitting the area with two permanent tennis courts and two permanent pickleball courts. I asked them to provide lines on the second tennis court for both tennis and pickleball courts. The second tennis court then could be used as a tennis court or be used as 2 additional pickle ball courts.

#17 TEE BOX:

I am sure that you have noticed that the ugly hedge surrounding the 17th tee box has been cut down. I am getting questions like ... "Are you going to leave it wide open like it is now?" The answer is "NO" ... I have picked out a couple of shrubs that will work in that area, one is called the Copperleaf. It is a popular shrub that provides many colors to a landscape. The leaves are a mixed copper, red, pink and green. The Copperleaf shrub will provide more color than most other flowering plants. This idea will be presented to the Golf Advisory Committee for their final approval.

POINT OF SALES STATIONS:

We have added three POS stations to our F&B operation, this will help expedite members cashing out. I also had the Tiki Bar hard wired for the internet so that we can eliminate the problems that we were having with Wi-Fi connection. We also added two cash boxes, one in the wait station by the kitchen and one out at the Tiki Bar. This will help expedite the cash customer and allow the server to move on to their next customer.

POOL AREA:

Your Board is working on improving the pool and Tiki Bar area during this upcoming summer. Plans are to re-surface the pool with a new pebble texture and to resurface the concrete deck area. They are looking at ways to increase table and chair capacity to provide more room for our members to have ample room to meet their friends and have a drink or two.

THE FIRE PIT AREA:

The area that I cook hot dogs for the HOT DOG FEAST is an area that the Board is looking at to put in a fire pit and create a casual lounging area for early evening gatherings.

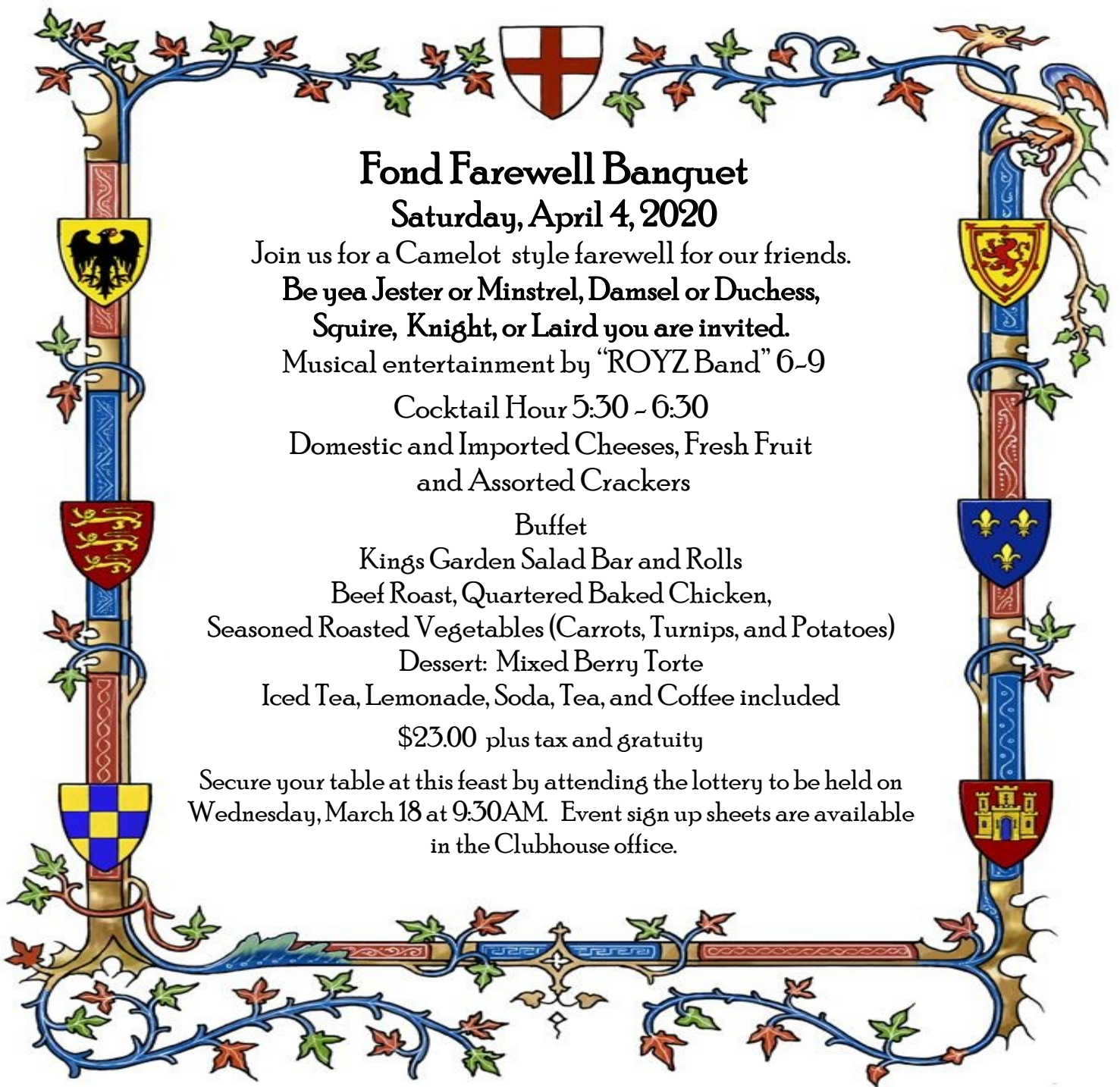

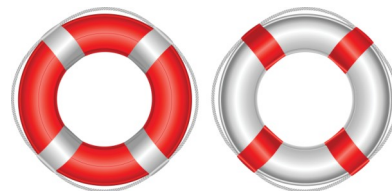
