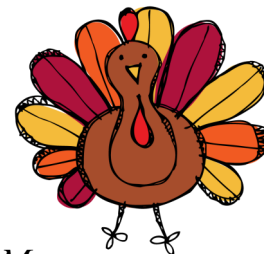

The PLGA have their election of officers Free Lunch and Scramble on Tuesday, November 9th. Make sure to sign up in the Pro Shop when we get closer to the date.

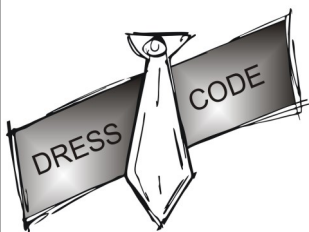
The PMGA will conclude the Director's classic on Wednesday, December 1st, with awards, lunch and scramble to follow on Wednesday, December 8th.

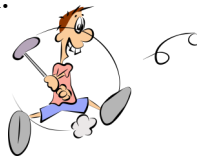

General Manager's Corner

The season is here, November 1st is traditionally the start of our winter season. That's when all of snow birds start to return to their winter homes to enjoy our 70-degree weather. Welcome Back Lucy!

Saturday was our traditional Halloween Party where we had 120 of our scariest members attending that evening, some with costume and some without. 😊

Welcome Back Party is on the 6th of November with Billy Agans providing music for the evening. This is a member only event and is Sold Out.

The Members Only Veterans Day Celebration is on the 11th of November with cocktails at 5 and ceremonies starting at 5:20. Don't be late. This event is Sold out.

Thanksgiving reservations for our three seating have started to fill up. The 2:30PM seating is full but we still have room at our 12:00PM and 4:30PM seating. Yes, we have opened up our reservations to the public, so I expect to fill up Thanksgiving by the end of this week. Don't wait too long to call to make a reservation or you might be stuffing your own bird.

Tiki Bar is the place to be this season and we plan to keep it open until 8:00PM each night until the weather gets so cold that you'll need to wear a sweater. Sundays we will continue our afternoon entertainment from 2:00 to 5:00PM. I have been hearing nothing but great reviews on how good #3 bulkhead turned out. Building it out and away from #3 green gave us enough room to raise up that deep slope by 3 feet and allowing us to give the golfer a safer area to hit their golf shot without falling into the water.

The new roofs are on the bathrooms out on the golf course. They look good with the composite barrel tile and they are guaranteed to last for 50 years. The bridge will be done by the second week in November.

Scammers and other Crimewatch/Safety Information

Welcome back to our snowbirds. I hope you had a wonderful time visiting friends, family and vacationing. We had a very hot summer, but thankfully no hurricanes, or other weather related disasters that many other states experienced.

The scams never seem to go away, they just 'expand' with the latest technology, including the popularity of using QR codes.

Sadly, scammers are taking advantage of this by changing QR codes to re-route consumers to malicious websites. Be wary when using QR codes and make sure that what you scan is approved by the business.”

To avoid QR code scams, Florida Attorney General Moody is offering the following tips:

Before scanning, make sure a QR code is from a reputable source;

- Watch for shortened URL links that may contain malware;
- Research and download a QR code app that has added security;
- Do not scan QR codes from an unknown source; and
- Look out for stickers placed over legitimate codes or other signs of tampering with codes at business locations.

Downloading security apps may help to keep devices free of malware but be sure to thoroughly research any such app to avoid mistakenly downloading malware.

If malicious malware is downloaded, visit the [Google Support Help Center](#) for information on how to remove unwanted ads, pop-ups and malware from a mobile phone or computer. Additionally, the Federal Trade Commission provides a detailed guide on how to recognize, remove and avoid malware.

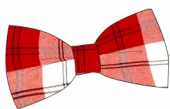
