General Manager's Corner

Hurricane Ian left us with a lot of cleanup on the golf course, around the clubhouse and the common areas. We lost a total of 57 trees, 37 on the golf course and 20 in our common areas. Ray's crew spent Friday, Saturday and Sunday moving all of the downed trees to the side of the fairways and picking up all of the debris. Due to the hard work of Ray and his crew of Ronny, Duck and Willis we were able to open the golf course on Monday.

After Ray and his crew completed their work Miguel, our Palm Tree Trimming Contractor, assisted us by cutting up the trees and hauling them away. The heavy debris that was all over the course was the most difficult clean-up due to its size and volume. Miguel and his crew also worked with us to move all of the golf course debris to the Maintenance area and then he hauled 14 dumpsters worth of debris to the landfill. The fencing on the back side of the homes on Pro Am came down during the storm, but James and his guys (Frank and Tom) put all of the fence posts back up. The posts were put in concrete and the fence was reattached to the posts. There are a few of our common area palm trees that are leaning which will need to be either cut down or straighten back up and anchored.

Fortunately there was no damage to the pool area, Clubhouse, Pro Shop or to the tennis /pickle ball court areas. After assessing our damages, I would say we were very lucky. The Clubhouse and Restaurant were open for business on Friday, with only two days being closed.

We are seeing a lot of our members coming back earlier this year than normal, whether it is because of the cold weather up north or having to deal with repairs from the damage caused by Ian. In any case it is nice to see them coming back early and spending their money.

And on that note, we have two new menus available. Our new appetizer menu will be available everyday from 11-8:00PM. Our new lunch menu offers a huge variety of options and includes several gluten free and vegetarian choices. If you have food allergies that require your meal be specially prepared, please tell your server and we will do everything we can to follow your request. If we cannot, we apologize and will try to find something that is within your restrictions.



After the Storm and More Information

Welcome back to our latest snowbirds that have now returned. We are glad that you are back. First of all, I want to say how grateful I am that we did not sustain the damage and devastation that our friends and fellow Floridians experienced south of us. For many, there will be no re-building, and for others they face a long journey towards recovery. I am so proud to see communities coming together and working towards helping those who needed help and will continue to need support for a long time. Within Peridia, so many neighbors helped others before the storm, securing their property and removing outside obstacles, while others during the storm opened their hearts and homes to those either living along and/or without power, even if they lost their own power. In the aftermath we all pitched in to help with the cleanup, checking on one another and offering what we could do for each other. For many of us this was our first major hurricane and we were not prepared mentally for the reality and gravity of the storm, but we survived. There are some lessons learned from this however, including preparedness, whether it be removing trees/overgrowth, trimming, replacing older screening ahead of time and other tasks that could have mitigated some of the damage and expense associated with the outcome.

I received several calls regarding our evacuation levels within Peridia. Manatee Co. does not evacuate by zone, but by levels, and has nothing to do with flood zones. It is based on the storm surge level of the area that we live in. This is the website information that you can utilize to find that information: mymanatee.org then under Government choose Public Safety then select Emergency Management and "Know your level", then highlight Residential Information Tool and type in your address as instructed. Most of Peridia is in Level D which is very good but there are parts of Wedge Court and the 4400 block of Pro Am that are in Level B probably because of their proximity to the lake and the creek that is behind them. Also, part of Kilty Ct. is in Level C but the rest of it is in Level D. The levels are based on need to evacuate starting with Level A being first and it moves forward through the alphabet accordingly, so please review your information as instructed above. Evacuation is always your decision; it is not forced. Luckily, we are on higher ground than many areas and not close to the beach. Also, you can call 311 M-F from 8-5 to get more information and to report street signs that are down as well as red lights that are not working properly. They are very helpful and took thousands of calls during the hurricane.

You know that I always remind everyone to lock their cars if left outside, and since my last column in Sept. we have had several burglaries of this type in Peridia and in Fairfax. They caught a couple of the culprits and arrested them, but the next day there were other cars that were entered and items were taken, so there is most certainly more than one group doing this. Also, a resident asked me to mention that if you are getting roof replacements, or other maintenance done, please make sure that your roofer or contractor sweeps the property with a magnet for nails after the project has been completed. Several people have encountered flat tires because of this! I want to give a BIG SHOUT OUT to Peridia's GM, Ray and his staff and other people contracted to help with the preparation before the storm and clean up. Tom, Ray and others were riding the golf course at daylight the day after the storm and immediately began the massive cleanup. If you see any of these people, take a minute to stop and thank them for their hard work. Stay Safe!




