General Manager's Corner

Golf course will be closed for overseeding after the LPGA finish playing on November 3rd and after the PMGA finish playing on the 4th. The Course will be closed all day on Thursday, November 5th. We will then be cart paths only thru Sunday, November 8th. We need to be cart paths only so that the seed that is put down on the fairways remains in the fairways. Fastest way to ruin the look of our over seeding is driving our carts through the seeded area and carrying the seed to area that weren't intended to get the seeded. Result...Ugly tire tracks everywhere.

This past week you have seen about a dozen workers working on our irrigation heads around the golf course. This team is from Toro irrigation and they are replacing the computer card in each of our 660 sprinkler heads that are on the course. Toro has had such a big problem with this part that they decided to replace the part on every sprinkler head, this repair will also extend our warranty by two years.

Our lighting for the tennis/pickleball courts have been changed out with LED bulbs. The wind screens are up. We have ordered replacement screens for the bad ones and have ordered additional screens for the expanded areas. We are just waiting for the additional pieces to arrive so that we can finish the job. The 4-foot fence divider between the pickleball courts has been put in, this new fence will help to stop the pickleballs from interfering with the play in the court next to it. Courts look great! Pickleball and Tennis players are very happy!

The pool has been resurfaced and the deck has been completely redone. They both look great! The new chairs and tables have started to arrive, James and Frank are putting them together and putting them on the deck as fast as they can. The furniture for the lounging area has been ordered, we are just waiting for those pieces to arrive to complete our fire pit area. I am hoping to have the Tiki area completely done by the end of November.

On the golf side, for the month of September, our rounds were up by 186 over September 2019. Our members rounds were 113 of that 186. The golf department beat their September budget by \$6,766. This summer has been a strong showing for member usage, member rounds are up by 2,929 YTD over the same YTD last year. I assume that all of you have read the posting on the Pro Shop doors that states:



The staff and I have been discussing the pros and cons on bringing back our buffets in November. At this time the cons are out numbering the pros. We are now planning to start bringing back our lunch buffets and our Sunday Brunch in early December. Again, this is a moving target, we will start our buffets as soon as we feel that it is safe to do so.

After many, many months of indecision about renovating the tennis-pickleball courts, on May 26 the Master Board appointed an ad hoc committee to investigate all possibilities and report back to the Board. The committee consisted of Pam Carlin, Bill Springer, Gary Marshall, Tom Frohne, Tom Donato and the chairman Mike Gutzler. The committee met many times for many hours over the next four weeks.

At the June meeting, the committee made its report. The report took into account the space available, the safety of the players and the cost. Said report was adopted unanimously by the Board. The report basically called for the extension of the existing court nine feet to the east, the permanent removal of the lighting on the east side and the safe configuration of two tennis courts and four pickleball courts.

At the same meeting the committee was given the additional task of formulating policy for the renovated facility which policy included allowing the general public to use our courts for a fee. These policies were presented to the Board in August and adopted unanimously. If you are interested in reading those policies, they may be found in the August 24 Master board minutes on the Peridia web site.

Construction began the second week of August. Taylor Tennis was the general contractor responsible for the milling of the old courts, and the complete reconstruction of the surface with new asphalt. They put two coats of black acrylic resurfacer on the entire court and then two coats of color along with silica sand and then painted on the two inch boundary lines. Costco Key Contractor Services was responsible for taking down the fence, repairing it, repainting it and rehanging it. Two additional posts were added. DNJ Crane Service removed the light poles.

The total cost for the project was \$97,320 An additional \$5,000 will be spent on accessories for the courts. The courts were reopened for play on October 3.

A big thank you goes to the committee for its hard work. And a bigger thank you goes to Mike Gutzler for his determined leadership in both getting the project started and in seeing it through to its successful conclusion.

All reports indicate that our members are well satisfied with our new courts. We now have a first class facility that might be attractive to potential new residents and should be a source of pride for all Peridians.


