Welcome back and as you can see Fall is upon us. The Golf Course is scheduled to be closed on November 7 and November 8 at 12:00, and also on November 9 all day. During these shut downs there will be pesticides being applied as well as overseed on the Tees, Collars, Approaches and Fairways, along with cultural practices such as verticutting, grooming, pencil tining, fertilizing and top dressing. Which brings me to top dressing, Top dressing is a mandatory process in the up keep of the greens. The greens need to be top dressed every 7-10 days with a light layer of sand, I will rotate the days, so that there is not sand on the greens the same day each week. Again, welcome back. Enjoy the Golf Course and I hope to see you out there.

Cyber Threats, FL “Do not call list” and maintaining a “Closed Door Policy”

Every day thousands of cyber threats are launched. These threats include malware that steals passwords and allows your smartphone or computer to be hacked. The cybercriminals have shifted their focus from exploiting vulnerable technology to targeting humans. Think before you click on a link and don't trust subject lines such as “immediate action required”. It's great to share things about yourself, but not online. Scammers routinely monitor social media accounts. Be discreet with what you reveal on social media. Don't accept invitations from strangers to be online friends.

Subscribing to the Florida do Not Call list is now being offered free of charge for residential and mobile telephone numbers. Sign up at www.fldnc.com. You can register up to 6 phone numbers and you will remain on the list for five years.

While an “Open Door Policy” is a good thing in the work place, it is a bad thing in the home place. Keep your doors locked and do not open your door to anyone that you do not know. Make sure that you can see who is at your front door, via peephole, side lights, or electronic monitoring, without opening the door. Also, make sure your door bell is working. If it is not, it most likely just needs either a new battery in the doorbell itself, or replacement batteries in the chime mechanism that is inside your house. This is an easy fix and an important factor to keeping you safe. Sometimes criminals will go up to homes and ring the bell to see if someone answers. If there is no answer, they often assume that no one is home and will see that as an opportunity to attempt to break in. If someone suspicious comes to your door asking for work, food, or money, tell them (through the door) that you are not interested and ask them to leave your property. Call 911 and give the dispatcher a description of the individuals and explain what happened. This enables the sheriff's department to dispatch a patrol unit to the area and if the individuals are still around, they will stop and question them and ask them to leave the area. Even though there are ‘no soliciting’ signs are our main entrance, they are often ignored.

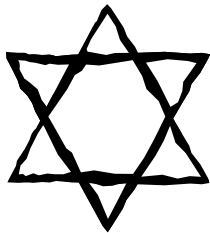

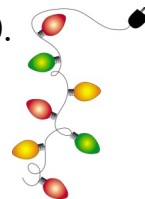

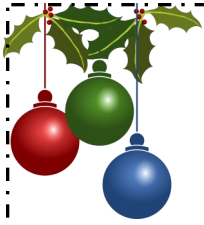
