Happy November everyone!! I hope all of you that have returned from the many Northern States have had an excellent summer. With cooler weather just around the corner, Winter Season is here.

The PLGA have their election of officers Free Lunch and Scramble on Tuesday, November 12th. Make sure to sign up in the Golf Pro Shop when we get closer to the date. The Jill and Jack event will also be held on Tuesday, November 19th so mark both of these dates on your calendars.

The PMGA will conclude the Director's classic on Wednesday, November 6th, with awards, lunch and scramble to follow on Wednesday the 13th of November. Sign up for the Free Lunch and Golf portion will be available in the Golf Pro Shop closer to the date.

The popular member 9 and Dine golf scramble and dinner has already started on Thursday evenings at 3:30pm. You can sign up a week in advance so please do so as this event fills up quickly. 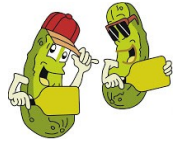

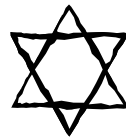

The DAV also operates a Service Office at 111 63rd Ave East. Our Service Officers receive 40 hours of training annually and are certified to file your forms with the VA. This office is manned Monday – Friday from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM and can be contacted at 941-752-2900. If you think you have a service connected injury or disease we will assist you in filing all VA forms to see if you qualify for service related disability compensation or an increase in compensation. Again, this is at no charge and you do not have to be a member. We mention this because the VA recently made the presumptive diseases associated with Agent Orange available to veterans who served off the shore of Vietnam (the Blue Water Navy). Compensation for similar presumptive diseases are approved for contaminated water for anyone who served at Camp Lejeune for 30 cumulative days between the dates of Aug 1, 1953 to Dec 31, 1987.

Recipe of the Month

Baked Spinach Artichoke Dip

INGREDIENTS:

- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 1 can (about 14 oz.) artichoke hearts, drained and coarsely chopped
- 1 box (10 oz.) package frozen chopped spinach, thawed and squeezed to drain
- 2 (8 oz.) packages cream cheese, softened
- 3 cloves garlic, minced
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice
- 1 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- Toasted baguette slices or assorted crackers



DIRECTIONS: Heat oven to 375° F

Lightly grease a 7x11 inch baking dish. In a medium bowl, mix together the cream cheese and mayonnaise until smooth. Mix in the artichoke hearts, spinach and Parmesan cheese. Season with garlic and lemon juice. Spread evenly into the prepared baking dish. Bake covered for 20 minutes. Remove the cover, and let the dish bake uncovered for 5 more minutes, or until the surface is lightly browned.
