A blue flag does not allow you to drive between the green and the next tee box. A blue flag does not allow you to drive between the green and sand traps. Also, no blue flags will be issued when cart path only is in effect. Driving carts too close to greens and tees will result in compaction problems. We want to keep Peridia and its golf course in great condition and this is one way to do that.

#### **General Manager's Corner**

I am happy to announce that Brad Little has joined our Peridia team as our Food and Beverage Manager. Brad comes to us after eleven years with Bill Casper Golf Management LLC. If you see him walking through the dining area, stop him and introduce yourself, he is very easy to talk to.

#### Below is a brief bio written by Brad:

I would like to introduce my self as your new Food and Beverage Manager. My name is Brad Little and I come to you from The Country Club of Eaglebrooke in Lakeland, Florida. I have spent over 15+ years in the hospitality industry in country clubs ranging from full private to public golf courses. I am originally from Toms River, New Jersey and moved to Tampa when I was 12 years of age. I am not married but, in a great relationship with my girlfriend Katie and we have 1 dog and 2 cats. I currently live in Brandon, Florida and look to move closer to Peridia in the near future. I have only been here for 2 weeks but I can already tell how much the members support the club and care for the staff and each other here. I am very happy that I decided to make the move to Peridia and look forward to meeting everyone.

The following is an update on our Capital projects:

**BULKHEADS ON #3 and #4:** Both bulkheads have been completed and both look fantastic. Replacing the square look of #4 bulkhead with a curved bulkhead has resulted in a much improved look.

**PUMP STATION:** The new 75 horse assembly for the pump house will be installed this week and the old 75 will be taken out to be repaired at same time. Once this is completed our golf course irrigation schedule will be back to normal.

**BRIDGE:** It is looking like it may be the first of October before the lumber is delivered. We are getting very close to the beginning of SEASON hopefully Eagle Golf will be able to get started on the project AS SOON AS the lumber arrives. I am pushing Eagle Golf on this project to complete the project by the middle of November. During the construction of the bridge, we will be reversing the two 9s so that our members will be finishing their round on # 9. This means that our # 10 hole becomes our # 1 hole and our #9 hole becomes our # 18 finishing hole. This will help with the traffic flow while the bridge is under construction.

**LAKE BANKS:** This year's lake bank project has been deferred to 2022 due to American Shoreline having to reschedule us for January due to their lack of employees.

**CART PATH:** We have decided to move the Cart Path replacement project to next year due to this year's extended rainy season and our concrete contractor being behind schedule. We will plan on starting the project next year after the winter golf season.
