Hurricane Preparation and Trending Scams

I would like to say to our beloved snowbirds: Welcome Back to Paradise. We have missed you and look forward to seeing you around the neighborhood! We have many new neighbors that have chosen Peridia as their new home since Spring. Make sure you get a chance to introduce yourself to our newest neighbors when you see them at the club, or at Pickleball, Tennis, Golf, or during your walks. Because we have so many new neighbors, I have provided some information below regarding Hurricane Preparation. This is from the Manatee Co. Utilities Department's website.

Early preparation enhances safety, reduces the amount of post storm debris, and ensures collection.

- During a storm, items in the yard lawn furniture, old bricks, tools, toys, etc. can become projectiles that could injure people and cause damage to buildings and automobiles.
- If the storm impacts our area, you may have debris. It may be downed trees and limbs, broken pool cages, roofing material, fencing, etc. from wind damage. It could also be yard and household items ruined by flooding. Trimming trees and eliminating unwanted broken items NOW will reduce the amount of debris you may have to deal with after a storm.
- When winds are high and conditions unsafe, garbage collection will be suspended leaving late-placed items uncollected at the curb. Preparing early means that the items are collected well before a storm nears.
- Do not leave garbage cans and recycling carts at the curb when a storm is approaching. Bring all cans and carts back to a secure location.

Also, the Office of Emergency Management recommends that you keep at least a half tank of gasoline in your vehicles in case you choose or are mandated to evacuate.

The most recent trending Scam is one that involves transferring money via the app Zelle. You receive a text that looks like a fraud alert from your bank that asks "Did you make a purchase of \$100 at a merchant". If you respond to the text, you will engage them and receive a call from a number appearing as a bank and they will ask you for a one-time code that they have sent you under false pretenses. Once they have that they will use it to enroll their bank account with Zelle using your e-mail or phone no. They can now receive your money into their account. Don't trust Caller ID, don't share codes based on calls you receive, and don't be pressured to act quickly. Another scam that has been brought to my attention involved FPL. A number will appear in your caller ID as FPL and they will advise that they have not received your latest payment and your power is due to be turned off within the hour. They request your banking info or credit card information and take your money. FPL will not call you regarding overdue bills. They will notify you by e-mail or regular mail.

There have been several unpleasant encounters in Manatee Co. these last few months associated with solicitors. 
