General Manager's Corner

First things first There is a rumor that is going around that I am going to resign as your General Manager. This is just a rumor started by our Golf Pro, Brian Schmidt. He started the rumor right after I beat him playing golf at a nearby golf course. Seriously, I think Peridia is a fantastic facility, members here are great, and the employees are very hardworking and they create an atmosphere where the members want to come out and enjoy their Club. So, I am not planning to leave anytime soon. Come on Brian challenge me again.

The Foxtail Palm Trees have been planted and with this rain are doing very well. I am working on a plot plan on where future trees need to be planted, including around the Clubhouse.

Galaxy pools started on August 12th replacing our pool's filtering system. It will take them 3 weeks to complete the job but then we will need an additional week for James and Frank to paint the deck. We are off schedule because of all the rain that has hit us this past 6 weeks. Those of you that have not seen the new sun sail that we put in last month, it is giving us some extra shade next to the Tiki Bar and we are planning to put in another sun sail on the other side of the Tiki Bar sometime this September. The pool and Tiki Bar area have become a very active area for our members to enjoy, if you haven't gotten out there to try it, please do so before the snowbirds get back.

The pool bathroom and the two Golf Pro Shop bathrooms have been re-tiled, we also put in new partitions and new sinks. We still have ceilings to repair and new lighting to put in, should have that all done in the next couple of weeks.

Bay Area Electric will be working with FPL to bring the upgraded wiring to handle the 1000 Amps that is coming in from FPL's transformer. FPL has scheduled this work for September 4th and 5th. The plan is to have FPL shut down the electricity to the Clubhouse for 2 days allowing the new service to be installed. During these two days, BAE will be working on the new gear box to get us up and running ASAP.

With all of this rain that we have had this summer the Long-Range Planning committee is looking at the Golf Course drainage problem. They are not going to have a solution with a snap of their fingers. There will be a number of meetings and a lot of ideas discussed before they can make a recommendation to the BOD. Please be patient.

Remember, I always have time for your questions or comments, so please stop by my office. My door is always open.



Safety Tips for Hurricane Season and Emergency Situational Awareness

Well it's that 'time of year' again where we have entered into hurricane season. We have many new residents, so I wanted to offer a few tips on preparing for and reacting to hurricanes.

First of all, have a plan. Do we stay or do we go? That is the question that we all ask ourselves and we should prepare for both situations. Think ahead and prepare for evacuation. Just simple things that we can do that will minimize stress and confusion in the midst of having to make that decision. Are you well stocked with water, batteries, non-perishable food? If you have a pet, do you have adequate pet supplies on hand, or if you take care of another person, are they prepared and provided for? Are medical records, prescriptions, pharmacy information and the like easily accessible should you have to evacuate? Do you know the evacuation route? Keep your vehicle filled with gas. Important documents should be in one location where you can easily transport them with you. If you do leave, take food, snacks, water, tissues, etc., as options can be limited along your travel route. Have emergency cash available because without power, credit card machines don't work. Keeping your phone charged and making sure you have a car charger in your vehicle if it did not come equipped with one can make the difference between having phone service or not.

Also, it is still very hot in the month of September, so please use caution while exercising and playing sports outside. The humidity can easily make the heat index over 100 degrees, so stay hydrated and keep water with you. If you observe someone having a medical emergency call 911 immediately. You can help and/or seek other help until emergency personnel arrive. Even if upon arrival they determine the person does not need to be transported, you have done the right thing by calling 911 first.
