Happy September everyone!! I hope you have enjoyed your summer thus far and are looking forward to the cooler weather ahead, I know that I am.









#### General Manager's Column

Some of you probably have seen that Mondragon is working on Saturdays trying to catch up with their schedule. I think they will be at least five days off their mark of September 11 to open the whole Golf Course. Once the Golf Course is open for 18 holes of play, Mondragon will still be on the lake banks finishing putting in the irrigation heads in those area. When we moved from the front side to the back, Mondragon started working from hole 9 backwards and in two days had the main line dug, laid, and filled all the way to hole 3. The damage from digging is not as disruptive as we had expected so the grow back will take less time than we had anticipated.

We still have our summer maintenance program in progress on both sides. Ray has to be very careful with this program because the water may be off for three or four days during the construction. We are trying not to be too disruptive for our members while they are on the Course playing golf but at the same time we have a lot of maintenance to be do and a shorter time to get it done. Please try to patient with us this summer, we are trying to give you a better product for 2019.

The restaurant remodel started on August 20, the time table for the work to be completed is September 11. We will open with our old chairs and tables. The new chairs have been delayed and will take an additional 2 weeks to arrive. We are going to be sending out pictures and short descriptions on the progress being made. During this time, you will see a Sysco truck parked in the parking lot. This is for storage of our food from our walk-in freezer and walk-in cooler. Our kitchen staff are cleaning, painting walls and degreasing floors, they are trying to get everything looking brand new and clean in the kitchen area.

The Tiki bar and the pool area are closed until we can acid wash the pool and paint the deck area. Last year, not knowing that we were going to open a Tiki Bar, we painted the pool deck with a water base paint and now we are finding out that the alcohol that is being spilled is causing the paint to peel. So, we will be re-painting the deck during the three weeks that the pool closed. I know this is an inconvenience having the pool closed for a lot of our members specially the Water Lilies who use the pool every Monday, Wednesday and Friday for their exercise class. Thank you for being so understanding.

Valerie Funk, our bookkeeper and friend, gave us her two weeks' notice. Val is moving on and will be working for ICON Management. We wish her the best of luck.

#### **President's Blog**

Peridia Golf and Country Club has weathered another hot, rainy summer, filled with irrigation replacement, restaurant renovations, and rest room renewals. Construction equipment could be seen within the community as well as on 45<sup>th</sup> Street and at the apartment complex at our entrance. Changes, changes, and more changes continue to occur as they always will. Each year as I return to Peridia from the north, physical changes have occurred. In addition, faces change, both Members and employees.

I'd like to dedicate this month's President's Blog to the Member/Employee Relationship in Peridia. Many employees have been here for years while others are new to the Club. From the GM to the new hires, employees have a job to do and they do it to the best of their ability. Employees have a code of conduct that's expected of them, not only by the Members, but by their immediate supervisors. They must mind their P's and Q's as they do their jobs.

As longstanding or new Members, we need to give the employees space, or room to do those jobs. We may think we know how they should do their jobs, but that is determined by the GM. We need to realize that we too have a code of conduct to follow when dealing with employees. I've included a small excerpt from our **Rules and Regulations** handbook as a reminder to all.

5. EMPLOYEES OF THE CLUB – Members and guests are to be respectful of Club Employees and are not permitted to reprimand Employees or in any way interfere with the management of the Club. Complaints from Employees will be directed to the General Manager who will investigate and report the findings to the Board of Directors. Upon the Board of Directors review, appropriate action will be taken which may include sanctions against the offender. Peridia will not tolerate harassment in any form as it is contrary to our policy of providing a positive working environment in which each of our Employees have an equal opportunity to develop and excel based on their knowledge, abilities and job performance. Any member complaints regarding Employees should be directed to the General Manager or the Board of Directors. Each complaint shall be reviewed in light of existing Peridia Golf and Country Club Policies and appropriate action taken.

#### 6. CONDUCT ...

A. All members and their guests shall conduct themselves, as they and their families would wish to be treated. Sanctions are provided for inappropriate behavior – including but not limited to the following behavior occurring on common grounds:

- 1. Profanity or insulting gestures
- 2. Screaming at others
- 3. Uncontrolled anger
- 4. Deliberate injury or threat of injury to others or to common property
- 5. Using facilities in an inappropriate manner or at an unacceptable time
- 6. Abusive language to or treatment of Club Employees
- 7. Failure to correct inappropriate behavior after Board of Directors warnings.

Members and employees are both valuable yet separate entities to our Club's success. They have different responsibilities to each other. It may be difficult to avoid feeling like a parent or grandparent to the younger employees, or difficult to forgive and forget previous experiences with Veteran employees but complications will arise if members let that occur. In the Member/Employee relationship, be respectful and friendly but avoid being friends. A happy, healthy and comfortable work environment is important for Peridia's Staff and Members.

Remember where you are, Know who you're talking to, Watch what you say, Somebody's listening and watching.



#### **Storm Preparation and Debris Management/Crimewatch Questions**

Well, it's that time of year again when we worry about storms and hurricanes. We have many new residents that may not be aware that early preparation enhances safety and reduces the amount of post storm debris. During a storm, items in the yard and on our lanai can become projectiles that could injure people and cause damage to buildings and cars. If a storm impacts our area, as it did last year with Hurricane Irma, we will have downed trees and limbs. Trimming trees and eliminating

unwanted broken items now will reduce the amount of debris you may have to deal with after a storm. Do not leave garbage cans and recycling carts at the curb when a storm is approaching. Bring all cans and carts back into a secure location. In Peridia, all garbage cans/recycle bins must be kept in an enclosed area and/or in the garage when they are not on the street for pick-up.

At the July Master Board meeting a new resident asked about the Crimewatch Committee so I thought I would share some information about it. We have residents that have volunteered to be on the Crimewatch committee that represent all components within Peridia. We do not 'patrol' the neighborhood, nor are there plans to have private security. Our streets are county owned and the sheriff's dept. does patrol our area on a regular basis and will add patrols if we believe they are needed. We have been fortunate to have little to no crime lately, other than the occasional items removed from unlocked vehicles or vandalism. Everyone should remain vigilant and protect their property. One of the best ways to stay safe is to get to know your neighbors – exchange phone numbers, know their routines so that if anything out of the ordinary occurs, such as newspapers and/or garbage cans not being removed from the curb, you can reach out to them to make sure they are OK. We recently had a neighbor that was found deceased after a concerned neighbor contacted the sheriff's office for a welfare check after seeing the recycle bin outside for a couple of days. Speeding within Peridia remains a problem but there will be no speed bumps installed. Increased traffic is due to the construction at the entrances on the 45<sup>th</sup> St. side which is not due to be completed until the end of 2019. If you see someone speeding and can get the tag number, contact the Manatee Co. Traffic Hotline, and report them (941 723-5197). This number, as well as other emergency phone numbers can be found in the front of the Peridia Resident Directory which is available for you to pick up in the business office.
