The light switch has been turned on and it is season again. For those of you who have been up north or just vacationing for the last 4 to 6 months, the following are some of the projects that we are working on:

POINT OF SALE:

NBC Sports NEXT is now ready to provide us with the new software for our hand-held tablets. This is scheduled to happen on November 2nd, during our off hours, so that if something should happen during the installation it won't interfere with our normal POS operations. There will be some training for our managers and then we will start our in-house training using one of the trained managers to train the wait staff. We have upgraded our Wi-Fi system to accommodate the new signal for the system.

SOUND AND VIDEO SYSTEM:

The work on our sound and video system has begun. The tech will finish running the new cable this week. The plan is to have the new hook-ups for the Clubhouse system completed, tested and ready to go for the Veterans night program. The crooks continue to be very 'crafty', and they are finding more ways to use technology to defraud older Americans. Emails stating that your account has been locked for nonpayment seems to place No. 1 in frequency the last few months. Whether it is your Amazon account, McAfee Security, etc., they are widespread and are difficult to block from your e-mail/phone because they use numerous e-mail accounts to send the notices. Just ignore them. If you have a question about a service that you subscribe to call that company directly, do not respond to any "Verify Account" requests. Free software exists that lets a caller falsify the caller ID that appears. Let all suspicious or unexpected calls go to voicemail.
