GENERAL MANAGER CORNER

TOTAL REVENUE and ROUNDS OF GOLF FOR 2023:

Our paid rounds of golf exceeded 2022 rounds by 2,320. That gave us a total round count for 2023 of 40,991. The break down for the 40,991 is as follows:

Members, 19,786 or 48% of total rounds.

Non-Member, 21,205 or 52% of total rounds.

Our total revenue from the golf operation was \$1,241,100. This total is \$151,329 greater than our 2022 golf revenues of \$1,089,771. Our 2023 golf revenue exceeded our 2023 budget by \$50,250.

TOTAL F & B REVENUE FOR 2023:

Our total revenue for our Food and Beverage department was \$1,294,276, this is \$136,962 or 11.5% greater than our 2022 revenue of \$1,157,314. The total food revenue for 2023 was \$881,679, this is an increase of \$106,758 over 2022 revenue. Our total beverage revenue for 2023 was \$412,597, this is an increase of \$30,204 over 2022. Our 2023 budget was aggressive, and with the hot summer, it did not help us with revenue, so, we ended 2023 with a short fall to budget of (\$65,755).

CREDIT CARD 2.7% SERVICE CHARGE:

As of the 1st of January, the club has been adding a 2.7% service charge to all sales in the pro shop, restaurant, and tiki bar. This service charge is added only to the public sales, no one from our membership pays this service charge.

LANDSCAPING:

Mid-February FLC will start replacing all the plants that Peridia lost this past year. The plan is to start with the hedge along the back of the clubhouse that faces the 18th green. There are several dead areas in the hedge that will need to be replaced and the hedge will also need to be trimmed back to encourage more growth. Along, Peridia boulevard, there are about 30 plants that died this past year that will need to be replaced. This will happen in phases with the hedge being the first phase.

SWIMMING POOL:

The water temperature for the pool was down to 58 degrees between Christmas and New year's. We had Galaxy out to look at the problem, they found the ignition switch was burned out, so they ordered a replacement, took two weeks to get it here. The switch has now been replaced and the temp is back up to where the ladies are happy again.

EVENT RESERVATIONS:

The club has four social events that fill up within the first hour after staff opens the reservation book. Those events are Halloween, The Illumination Party, Member Holiday Party, and the Snowbird Ball. We have hundreds of you that want to attend all four events but are unable to get in because the event fills up before you can get your table reservation into Mona. There is no easy answer to this problem, but we are working on a couple of changes that will give the membership a fair opportunity to make a reservation. As soon as we get it tweaked, we will sit with the social committee to get their opinions.

Remember, I always have time for your questions or comments, so please stop by my office. My door is always open.




