### From the Golf Course Superintendent

The weather is starting to warm up and with this I will be incorporating our spring and summer maintenance schedule. We will start vertical mowing, grooming, spiking, light top dressing and applying pesticides on a more frequent basis to the greens. These practices are necessary in their upkeep. You will also notice a lot more spot spraying of herbicides throughout the golf course to help control Spring and Summer weeds.

The Ryegrass on the fairways, collars and approaches will also start turning brown and dying off. This is known as transition. We will also be applying herbicides and other cultural practices to help with the transition from the Rye back to the Bermuda grass.

The golf course will be closed on Thursday, May  $16^{th}$  and re-open Monday, May  $20^{th}$ , at that time we will be aerating the greens, tees, collars, and approaches as well as deep spiking the fairways along with applying herbicides. On Tuesday, May  $28^{th}$  and or Wednesday, May  $29^{th}$  we will be



having our drainage systems on the golf course cleaned out and inspected, this is done every 2 to 3 years as preventative maintenance.

### Tips to be Safer Tomorrow

Happy May!!!! If the next 6 months move as quickly as the last few, our snowbirds will be back before we know it -I enjoy them very much and always look forward to their return.

2024 has thus far been interesting hasn't it? Very little rain, the highest winds that we have seen in a nonhurricane season, tons of new restaurants have opened, more road construction/disruption and more to follow that – as well as losing our GM. Also, what the early Spring weather has brought is an uptick in attempted car break-ins, vandalism, burglaries and the ever persistent solicitors. I suspect we will see this trend continue and perhaps even expand when school gets out. For Peridia, we have been very fortunate not to have seen as much of this as our neighbor Fairfax has. This should alert us to be more vigilant with regards to protecting our property, including cars, golf carts, anything that can be damaged or stolen. I believe that most people already do the things that I have repeatedly mentioned in this column, such as keeping garage doors closed, locking cars if they are left outside, never leave anything of value in your car, keep doors, windows and sliding glass doors locked, and using your alarm system, if you do not have one, at least use a Ring doorbell, and most of all do not open your doors to anyone that you do not know. Let your neighbors know when you are going to be away overnight, get someone to monitor your doorstep for package deliveries and either forward your mail if you are going to be away for an extended period of time, or get a neighbor to get it for you. Don't leave the signs in your yard for days and days that the lawn services place there acknowledging that they have sprayed your lawn. That is a tell-tell sign that you are away and makes you a greater target for crime. I have noticed in my daily review of the Manatee Co. Sheriff's Dispatch report that people are reporting suspicious activity, suspicious persons, etc. more often and I am so glad to see that. If the criminals see that the sheriff's department is patrolling more, they will go elsewhere. Also, if you are a snowbird, maybe hiring a person to check on your house while you are away, both inside and out is a good idea. Just let your neighbors know that someone will be doing that so they will not think that person is up to no good. Also on another note, there are some things you can do to make it harder for scammers to reach you, such as the following:

Open your iPhone's contact list and add your family, friends, doctors and other important numbers, then go into your phone settings and turn on the setting for 'silence unknown callers'. This will send any caller who is not in your contacts list directly to voicemail. Make sure you have signed out of any financial apps on your phone or PC, credit cards, etc. Make sure your account setting requires security measures such as a PIN; this ensures that if your phone is stolen the thief will not have access to your money. Move cards from your wallet or purse that you do not need to carry such as your SS card or Medicare card. Make copies front and back of the ones that you do carry so you will have that information readily available if your purse/wallet is stolen. Make sure your media settings are marked private which only allows people you choose to trust to view your pages and contact you.

### **Committee Update**

The entire Tiki Bar Committee plus Food and Beverage Manager, Brad Little, met for over 2 hours on April 17. They again discussed moving the outdoor food and beverage service to the patio area outside the pro shop during construction. In addition to the tables and chairs already under cover in that area, Brad and his staff will be moving 6 round tables and 24 chairs to the area Monday evening, May 27. Brad will also be purchasing 6 new colorful crank-able shade umbrellas for those tables. He hopes to have the area open by 11:00AM on Tuesday, May 28<sup>th</sup>.

TBC focused primarily on the cladding for the front of the bar and continued to research higher quality bar chairs than what we presently have now. Four bar chair samples have been brought to the meetings for discussion.

In addition, Bruce Webb has had several individual conversations with Liz, our bookkeeper, and several subcontractors, all in preparation to get things coordinated and running smoothly.

To date, the TBC has placed an order with Russo's Restaurant Supply in the amount of \$22,241.78 for new bar equipment. They have also ordered the burnt bamboo cladding for the front of the bar. The proposal for electrical work with Hoops Electric Service has been signed. The proposal with BN Design for the custom bar top design and installation has been signed. The proposal with RT Moore, the plumbing subcontractor, has been signed. Bruce purchased the sewage pump and grease interceptor from Ferguson Enterprises, saving us over \$2000. Bruce met on site with the president of Pro Playgrounds, the pavilion contractor. Fabrication is on schedule; the structure will be delivered, and roof construction will start the week of June 10th

The last Old Tiki Bar party, with special food and music, will be May 26th. The last day to use the pool and order poolside food and beverage service will be Memorial Day, May 27th. In-house work to remove TVs, fans, POS equipment, router and internet service, security cameras and equipment, bar and beverage equipment, disconnecting water and electrical service will begin early on May 28<sup>th</sup>. Demolition will begin early on May 29<sup>th</sup>.

This area will be a work zone for several weeks including when the pool deck is refinished and resurfaced. At this time there has been NO decision on opening the pool at any time during the construction. Most of the time the pool will need to be covered to protect it from debris, chemicals, construction dust, and concrete dust and particles, as well as to meet Manatee County work zone safety requirements.
