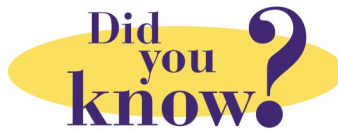

Here is a brief re-cap of what happened last month at Peridia.

The damaged and torn wind screens at the tennis/pickleball courts have been replaced.

All the burned-out lights in the parking lot have been replaced.

The fountain in front of the Club was drained and cleaned, the lights are once again on at the fountain in the big lake beside the Tiki Bar.

The latest fire inspection at the Club showed no violations.

The beer cooler behind the bar in the Club died and had to be replaced.

The Club hosted the home school prom on May 11 with 110 in attendance, On Mother's Day, 321 members and guests dined at the Club. The Derby Party was a success.

In March, April and the first 15 days of May, the number of golf rounds played was greater than for the comparable periods in 2023. This has made a dent in the months of January and February when golf rounds were down. The Memorial Day golf scramble was sold out with a waiting list of 20. A complete aeration of the golf course- tees, greens, and fairways - occurred May 16-20.

Brad has indicated that training on the new point of service devices will begin after the Tiki Bar is shut down.

Finally, a committee has been interviewing potential General Manager candidates. They have considerably pared the original list of 25. The next step in the process will be determined by the Master Board in executive sessions. However, the process continues to move forward smoothly. I will probably address the matter again by email since the next Scorecard will not come out until August.

We continue to have the presence of a Master Board member each day in the office. And if you are aware of problems or see matters that need to be addressed, please do not hesitate to call, or email me.

Staying Safe in the Heat, Recent Scams and Crime Activities in our Area and local updates

Welcome to June and July! It is already very hot, so prepare for an even hotter summer. Those of us who have been in Peridia for several years have gotten more used to the heat and humidity, but that does not mean that we should not pay attention to it with regards to outside activities. Heat stroke is very serious and often causes death. Even when it is overcast, high temperatures and humidity make it feel much hotter and that is what our bodies react to. Staying hydrated is extremely important during the summer months. Drink water prior to being outside, and continue to do so while exercising, playing golf or any other outside activities. If you feel lightheaded get into a cool environment as soon as possible and let someone know how you are feeling. If you see someone walking that appears to be in distress, or a teammate, reach out to them and seek medical attention if necessary.

One of the latest scams that has been brought to my attention is people receiving phone calls from a company pretending to offer assistance regarding a car accident that you were in within the last year, minor or major. It could be as little as someone bumping into your car with a shopping cart. They claim they can obtain reimbursement from you for any medical expenses or property damage your vehicle received at no charge – once you provide the necessary information to them. Do not fall for this one – it is not legitimate. Also, people are receiving statements from their credit card companies that look exactly like they were mailed from Citibank, Discover, etc. They instruct you to call them regarding a past due balance immediately before it is turned over to a collection company which will negatively affect your credit rating. When you call, they answer as though they are representing the company and ask ‘for security purposes’ that you verify your personal information. Again, this is a scam. If you think that you may have an overdue balance, hang up and call the customer service number for the financial institution that you do business with, or if it is a bank, go to a local bank and speak to someone there.

Locally, we have not had any reports of crimes in Peridia lately. Surrounding communities including Fairfax and Sabal Harbor have not reported anything significant in the month of May. There are quite a lot of calls in our area regarding solicitors who have become more aggressive and disrespectful. Again, don’t open the door to them, if you see them while you are outside, ask them to leave your property, if they are rude or you feel threatened by them, call 911. Remind them that we have ‘no soliciting’ signs at our entrances; do not argue with them. It is very annoying but there doesn’t seem to be anything we can do to keep them from continuing to solicit.

Just a quick update on the business that is going in where the 7/11 was at 45th and SR 70. Initially I advised it would be a medical marijuana dispensary and even though it was reported by others on Nextdoor that it was going to be a Cookie Company, it is in fact a medical marijuana dispensary by the name of “COOKIES”. They are out of Tampa and have stand-alone dispensaries at various locations in Florida. Supposedly you must have a medical marijuana card to purchase their products. I do not know, but I personally think there could have been a better alternative for the use of the property.

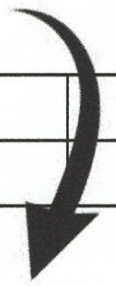

Committee Update

On Tuesday, May 28th, Brad and his team opened Tiki at the Green, our temporary location for outdoor food and drinks, outside the pro shop. Relax after your round of golf with lunch and a bucket of your favorite beer, while the new Tiki Bar is under construction.

Tuesday, May 28th was a busy day for our staff as they removed TVs, fans, POS equipment, router and internet service, security cameras and equipment, bar and beverage supplies and equipment, disconnect water and electrical service in preparation for demolition of the old Tiki Bar. **THE POOL AND POOL DECK WILL REMAIN CLOSED DURING CONSTRUCTION.**

On Wednesday, May 29th, Forristal Enterprises began the demolition process as well as core drilling in four locations for the new Tiki Bar roof supports. On June 10th, Legacy Construction starts the build for the new Tiki Bar roof structure.

BEHIND THE SCENE. Hoops Electrical Service has completed the preliminary rough in electrical work and RT Moore, the plumbing subcontractor, has completed the rough in plumbing. The TBC met with Russo, our new bar equipment supplier, to fine tune the equipment that is on order. They continue to work with Liz, our bookkeeper, to create and finalize purchase orders. They ordered 25 non swivel bar chairs, custom made in Florida, with a pearl-colored powder coated aluminum frame (with a five year warranty) and Caribbean Cane Textilene sling fabric. The burnt bamboo cladding for the front of the bar is already on site as well as other needed accessories.

We will keep you updated on the progress via emails, but also sign up on the Friends of Peridia Facebook page (now over 100 followers) for pictures of the new construction. Dates for the soft opening, Grand opening, and New Tiki Bar parties and activities will be posted via emails, Friends of Peridia Facebook Page, and in the August Scorecard.
