General Manager's Corner

It's been an exciting month as I've started to settle into the General Manager role here at Peridia. First and foremost, I would like to extend a sincere thank you to all that attended my reception and everyone that dropped by the office to say hello and welcome me to the Club. I enjoyed telling my story and sharing some of my experiences and career highlights. I truly appreciate the warm welcome and truly look forward to getting to know everyone better and learning more about the Club, the Staff and Membership.

I was extremely honored to be invited to join the Members for the Fourth of July Scramble. The golf course conditions were fantastic, and I want to recognize our Golf Course Superintendent, Ray Bartels and his team for their efforts maintaining this beautiful property. Brian Schmidt also joined our group, and it was a pleasure to be given the grand tour of the golf course by our Head Golf Professional. The Club is lucky to have Brian's leadership in the golf operation and his passion for Peridia was evident as he shared his insight and experiences over the last seven seasons.

The transition over the last few weeks has been mostly a smooth one, largely due to the efforts of our staff. Liz, Nancy, Mona, Autumn, Nicole, Stephan and Drew have been a great resource during the onboarding process and have done a tremendous job helping me settle in and navigate the "behind the scenes" operation at the Club. Last week, I had the opportunity to meet with the Restaurant Committee, alongside our Executive Chef, Elliot Johnson to discuss some of the challenges that the Club has been facing in recent years. The meeting agenda was extensive and we were able to prioritize several items that can be addressed immediately to make improvements to the level of service, menu offering, specials and pricing. This list includes the possible addition of a monthly Saturday Night Supper Club event and a weekday Appy Hour from 4-6 on Tuesday & Thursday. The Monday Madness Buffet pricing has also been adjusted by from \$8 to \$10 to reflect rising food and delivery costs we are experiencing.

As many of you already know, we have been searching for a new Food & Beverage Manager due to the recent departure of Brad Little. Brad has accepted the Assistant General Manager position at Sarasota National and we wish him the best in his new endeavor. I'm happy to report that we have hired a new Food & Beverage Manager, Ms. Brittney Szelag. Brittney joins us most recently from the Bird Key Yacht Club, where she served as the Front of House Manager. She began her career serving and bartending at a some highly regarded local establishments, Columbia Restaurant and Wheat & Water, followed by The Ritz Carlton and The Resort at Longboat Key Club, where she focused on events, staff training and delivering high quality fine dining experiences to the Guests and Membership. Brittney will start in mid-August and we are looking forward to her arrival. In the meantime, the front of house team will be working on point-of-sale training, service training and getting ready for the much-anticipated opening of the pool area and Tiki Bar. We expect to have a detailed announcement as the Master Board, Tiki Bar Committee and I finalize an exact date as more work is completed over the next month. The Master Board has also approved the capital expense for new pool furniture and sound system to include the clubhouse and pool area. I expect a soft opening to work out any reopening issues followed by celebration event around Labor Day Weekend to officially christen this wonderful new amenity. Our website will also be getting a facelift, to include a higher functionality for online Member tee times and increased visibility of our event and dining room offerings to the public.

Throughout my career, I've been in similar situations and had an opportunity to play a significant role in reorganizing the Club's offerings to best meet the needs of the Club and the Membership. The goal is to be innovative but also to be financially responsible in our approach to managing operations, purchasing, pricing and inventory revenue management. In closing, I would like to extend a sincere Thank You to President Roell and the entire Master Board, the Search Committee, including Tom Andreacci, Bob Schippnick, Sandy Frank and the entire Interview Committee that I had the pleasure of meeting with during my preliminary visit in June. It didn't take long to realize what a special place this is and how much the staff and membership cares about the Members and the future of Peridia Golf & Country Club.

Tiki Bar Committee Update

Creative Resurfacing Solutions has finished the repair of cracks and failing concrete on the pool deck. They applied two color (Beach Sand) coats with grip additive and application of tinted Stain sealer with grip additive. Acrylic sealant put along the base of the coping and in all cracks. They ground all rough surfaces inside the bar, where the old columns were, and filled in a low spot outside the tiki bar wall.

Waiting for additional rough electrical work, restarting the fountain, and the plumbing installation of the new sink and hot water heater.

The tiki structure will be temporarily covered so a night time acrylic pour over 150 sq ft of bar top covered with 350 pounds of sand can be installed.

We have 2 more electrical inspections, 2 more plumbing inspections, and a final inspection before the soft opening of the pool and new Tiki Bar.


