



General Manager's Corner

Dear Members,

First and foremost, we are extremely fortunate to have survived Hurricane Milton with mostly minor damage throughout Peridia, with about 20 screen porches being destroyed and only a few homes with fallen trees causing roof damage. We are very lucky that none of our staff or residents were hurt during the storm. In total we lost about 30 trees around the golf course, 5 streetlights in the parking lot and boulevards and over 700' of the perimeter fencing along 45th St. Ray, Brian, James and their teams did a great job clearing the debris from the course and getting the property reopened as soon as possible. The tree stumps and debris piles in the parking lot will be removed in short order. In total, the non-insurable damages are around \$50,000. We are still in the process of finalizing electrical quotes for the streetlights and some additional items needing replacement. The county has started clearing the curbside piles of debris leaving the street sign replacement among the final items to complete.

As the seasons change and we begin to welcome our seasonal Members back to the club, it's a perfect time to reflect on all the exciting developments and events happening at your Club. We've been hard at work enhancing both your experience and our amenities, and I'm thrilled to share a few updates with you:

Restaurant Survey Results: Your Feedback Matters... Thank you to everyone who participated in our recent restaurant survey. Over 200 surveys were completed.
