Latest Scams and Recent Updates about our community

Welcome Back to all our snowbirds, and a big Welcome to new residents who are lucky enough to have chosen Peridia as your new home. You will love it here and if you haven't done so already, get involved in the numerous activities that Peridia has to offer. Review your monthly Scorecard for more information.

What a year we have had. It reminds me of the Clint Eastwood movie, "The Good, the Bad & the Ugly". The year started off well with only moderate rain and pleasant temperatures. Then came May with no rain followed by almost 17" in June, July brought 100+ temps, almost 26" of rain in Aug. and 12" in Oct. with three hurricanes - the worst for us being Milton. As is typical with weather related disasters, it brings out the best in people, and unfortunately the worst in others – those trying to take advantage of the situation by overcharging, under-delivering and worst of all disappearing with the down payment for work to be performed that is never done. It is always best to use someone that you have experience with or is referred to you by a neighbor, but when we are presented with the after- hurricane scenario of more work than people to do it, it is hard to always know if we have chosen the right person. For larger jobs such as structural repairs, etc. always ask for the contractor's license number and verify that it is under the same name as the person you are dealing with, or that of the company they work for. It is illegal to work using someone else's license number unless they are an authorized agent of the company the license is registered to. Also, one of the latest scams is people receiving phone calls supposedly from your HOA or a roofing company that you have not contacted, saying they need to inspect your roof for damage. Do not fall for this, it is a scam and if you allow them to come, they go on your roof and actually damage it so that you will need repairs or replacements that you otherwise did not need. On the other hand, I witnessed so many people checking on our neighbor's homes, cleaning up debris for those who were unable to do it, and offering a place to stay while repairs were being made. Also, if you had a generator, you were 'every one's best friend' as you graciously opened your home to those without power. There is still a lot of debris to be removed throughout our neighborhood and other parts of the county so please be careful as you walk and drive around. Reports of debris damaging cars have been numerous. It's not always easy to see, especially when there are still so many street lights that are not working, and also be aware that many of the stop signs, and other road signs are down, so pack some extra time and patience when driving.

Our crime rate remains very low in our community and also in the surrounding areas, but please continue to protect your property, lock your doors, keep garage doors down and look out for one another.


